WHEREAS by section 1 (2) of Federal Revenue Court Decree 1973 it is provided that the Federal Revenue Court shall consist of the President and such number of Judges (not being less than 4) as the Head of the Federal Military Government may by order prescribe :

AND WHEREAS by section 2 (1) of the aforesaid Decree it is provided that the President of the Federal Revenue Court shall be appointed by the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee :

NOW, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint **MR JUSTICE JOHN ANIRMEKA PHIL-EBOSIE** as President of the Federal Revenue Court with effect from 1st February, 1976.
