#### WESTERN NIGERIA MARKETING BOARD

# APPOINTMENT OF LICENSED BUYING AGENTS FOR THE 1976-77 COFFEE SEASON

It is notified for general information that the Board is prepared to consider applications from persons in any of the three States of Oyo, Ondo and Ogun for appointment as licensed buying agents for the 1976-77 Coffee Season which will open in due course. The exact date will be notified by publication in this Gazette. 2. Applicants will be required to indicate the State/States in which they intend to operate and produce evidence that they are likely to be able to fulfil the minimum conditions set out in the following paragraphs, which are based on :--

(a) the normal functions which a licensed buying agent is required to perform;

(b) ability to purchase and handle a minimum purchase requirement of 200 tonnes.

(c) stipulated conditions as regards storage, evacuation, etc.

3. Functions of Licensed Buying Agents.—The main functions which licensed buying agents will be required to perform on behalf of the Board are :—

(a) to grade coffee at buying stations at not less than the minimum prices;

(b) to bag and arrange for inspection in accordance with the regulations ;

(c) to finance purchases and provide suitable storage until the time of evacuation to port;

(d) to make returns of gradings and stocks as the Board or its duly authorised Executive may require;

(e) to arrange for conveyance and delivery of coffee to Apapa according to instructions which may be issued from time to time by the Board's Executive ;

(f) to comply with regulations and instructions regarding check-weighing and inspection at port.

4. Minimum conditions.—(a) Purchases : Applicants must produce evidence of ability to purchase with reasonable regularity throughout a season a minimum of 200 tonnes of coffee.

(b) Applicants must produce evidence of necessary organisation to ensure proper performance of the duties of a licensed buying agent.

(c) Storage.—Applicants must be able to provide evidence that they have available in their proposed areas of operation proper storage for at least one hundred tonnes of coffee. All stores must comply with the requirement of, and be approved by the State Produce Inspection Service. It is the responsibility of the applicant to request, in writing, the Produce Officer of the area concerned to inspect and approve his stores.

(d) Capital.—Applicants will be required to produce acceptable evidence of their ability to satisfy the minimum capital requirement necessary to fulfil the obligations of a licensed buying agent. The minimum capital requirement is №10,000.00.

(e) General.—Applicants must be prepared to produce satisfactory evidence to show that they are fully conversant with the coffee trade and likely to be able to fulfil the following conditions :—

(i) Inspection of Coffee.—That they will be able to provide an adequate labour force at all stores to handle coffee at the time of inspection.

(ii) Returns.—That they will render promptly and accurately all returns particularly of gradings and stocks, which may be called for.

(iii) Evacuation.—(a) That they will be able to make arrangement to secure the necessary transport to ensure the smooth and regular evacuation of coffee by approved routes.

(b) That they possess the necessary organisation at port or the ability to secure reliable agents to ensure the carrying out of all duties involved in the delivery of coffee to Board stores.

5. Method of application.—Application forms and details as to their completion can be obtained free of charge from the Headquarters of the Western Nigeria Marketing Board, Cocoa House, Bank Road, Ibadan.

6. Firms and persons wishing to apply must forward their applications forms, duly and correctly completed in duplicate, to reach General Manager, Western Nigeria Marketing Board, Cocoa House, Bank Road, Private Mail Bag No. 5032, Ibadan not later than 30th June, 1976. Applications received after that date or not properly completed will not be considered. Firms and persons already appointed as licensed buying agents under the current Board's Marketing Scheme for coffee are not required to re-apply.

(ii) the contruction of 24m long bridge on each carriageway at km 15 approximately and the construction of pipe and box culverts of varying sizes.

(iii) the continuous maintenance of the existing Okene-Ajaokuta laterite road including improvement to sharp bends and the strengthening of bridges and culverts to ensure continuous flow of traffic throughout the duration of the new construction.

(a) Promoting the productivity and the better utilisation of agricultural labour force.

(b) Improving the effectiveness of rural education and vocational training schemes.

5. To assist in the establishment of a national immigration policy taking into account both positive and negative aspects involved in the importation of foreign workers.

6. To assist in the activities of the Secretariat of the Permanent Council and the Demography and Manpower Planning Section in the performance of their functions.

7. To organise and co-ordiante the activities of the members of the Mangower team.

8. To train national counterparts.

Qualifications required.—Knowledge of and work experience in manpower planning and employment policy in connection with the planning of economic and social development as well as with general economic policy.
