14. *Reserve for Unexpired Risks.*—The rate of 40 per cent of Net Premiums has been adopted as generally practised in the Insurance Industry for own Premium's Incomes except in the Marine, Aviation and Transit Division where a rate of 100 per cent has been considered necessary in view of the considerable time-lag between the notification of Claims and settlement.
