11. Taxation of the Corporation's Profits.—By the provisions of section 5 (2) of the Decree which established the Corporation, no Tax liability will arise until the General Reserve Fund of the Corporation is equal to twice the Paid-Up Capital. At the present growth rate of the business of the Corporation, it may not be too long before this level is reached and the Corporation will then become liable to Federal Tax payments.

14. Reserve for Unexpired Risks.—The rate of 40 per cent of Net Premiums has been adopted as generally practised in the Insurance Industry for own Premium's Incomes except in the Marine, Aviation and Transit Division where a rate of 100 per cent has been considered necessary in view of the considerable time-lag between the notification of Claims and settlement. The same rate was adopted in the previous financial years.

15. Contingent Liabilities.—The Corporation had no contingent liability in respect of guarantees on Promissory Notes issued by Commercial Banks and discounted with the Central Bank of Nigeria at 31st December, 1975 (1974 Nil). 16. NICON Staff Provident Fund and Pension Scheme.—The negotiations regarding this Scheme have still not been concluded. A further account of N250,000 has been provided in the Accounts of the Corporation

for the year ended 31st December, 1975 in order to meet the costs of the Scheme. The total provision of N490,000 made up to date for the Scheme is as follows-
