2. **Salary.**—Grade Level 08 (₦3,264-₦4,164) (points of entry will depend on qualifications and experience).

3. **Duties.**—They should take charge of virus diagnostic and/or quality control laboratory in the virus diagnostic and viral vaccine quality control laboratories.

4. **Qualifications.**—A basic medical qualification registrable with the Nigerian Medical Council. Previous experience in diagnostic virology and/or quality control of vaccines is desirable but not essential.
