WHEREAS by section 122 (2) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Basic Provisions) Decree 1975 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1976 it is provided that the Judges of the High Court of Lagos State shall be the Chief Judge of Lagos State and such number of other Judges (not being less than five) as may be prescribed by law :

AND WHEREAS by section 123 (3) of the Constitution of the Federation, modified as aforesaid, it is provided that if the office of Chief Judge of Lagos State is vacant or if the person holding the office is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, then, until a person has been appointed to and has assumed the functions of that office or until the person holding the office has resumed those functions, as the case may be, those functions shall be performed by such one of the other Judges of the High Court of Lagos State as may from time to time be designated in that behalf by the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee :


NOW, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint MR JUSTICE JAMES OLAJIDE KASSIM to act as Chief Judge of the High Court of Lagos State with effect from 15th day of October, 1976 during the absence on leave of the Chief Judge.
