The Agency is a body corporate of the Federal Government of Nigeria established by Decree No. 5 of 1977, and charged with the executive responsibility for the promotion and development of science and technology, including responsibility for research institutes, science policy advice, and allocation of funds for research.

A. POLICY AND PLANNING DEPARTMENT:

(I) Director/Assistant Director:

Duties.—The successful candidate will be responsible to the Executive Secretary for :

- (a) preparing an integrated master-plan for the development of science and technology in the country, and monitoring its implementation;
- (b) assessment of the financial requirements for implementing the science plan, and coordinating annual financial allocations;
- (c) co-ordination of socio-economic research relevant to the development of science and technology in the country, and monitoring socio-economic constraints in the application of science and technology to agricultural, industrial and social development;

(d) assessment of the impact of national scientific effort on development activities.

Qualifications.—A good honours degree in economics or related subject with at least 10 years' post-graduate experience which should include research as well as development planning. A higher degree will be an advantage.

(ii) Chief Planning Officer, Principal Planning Officers, Senior Planning Officers, Planning Officers, Grades I and II.

Duties.—To assist with agricultural, industrial and medical research planning in relation to development and assessment of impact of research on development activities.

Qualifications.—A good honours degree in economics or related subject with suitable experience (research or planning) in development, industrial, agricultural or mathematical economics, 7 years for Chief Planning Officer, 5 years for Principal Planning Officer, 3 years for Senior Planning Officer, and 2 years for Planning Officer, Grade I.

B. MEDICAL AND BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES DEPARTMENT

(i) Director Assistant Director Chief Scientific Officer:

Duties.—The successful candidate will be responsible to the Executive Secretary for:

(a) identifying policies and priorities for research in medical and biological sciences, and providing support to Agency Committees on medical and biological sciences research;

 (b) co-ordination of research programmes and budget proposals for research institutes and special research projects in the Universities in the field of medical and biological sciences;

(c) ensuring the implementation of Agency programmes on medical and biological sciences research; dissemination and application of research results;

Qualifications.—A good honours degree in a medical science or related biological science subject. A higher research degree will be an advantage. At least 5 years, post-graduate experience in research or related activity in the case of Principal Scientific Officer, 3 years for Senior Scientific Officer, 2 years for Scientific Officer, Grade I.

C. Physical and Industrial Sciences and Technology Department:

(i) Chief Scientific Officers:

Duties.—(a) co-ordination and evaluation of research activities in the physical and engineering sciences, industrial research and technology.

- (b) problems associated with utilisation of research results; assessment and exploitation of local inventions;
 - (c) scientific and technical manpower development;
- (d) technology policy and issues of transfer of technology.

Qualifications.—A good honours degree in physical sciences, engineering or technology and a higher research degree. At least 7 years' post-graduate relevant experience.

(ii) Principal Scientific Officers, Senior Scientific Officers, Scientific Officers, Grades I and II:

Duties.—To assist with the collection, collation and evaluation of research and development activities, and of information on transfer of technology. Application of results to industrial development.

Qualifications.—A good honours degree in physical sciences, engineering or technology. Higher research degree will be an advantage. Suitable experience in research or related activity, 5 years for Principal Scientific Officers, 3 years for Senior Scientific Officers and 2 years for Scientific Officers, Grade I.

D. AGRICULTURAL SCIENCES DEPARTMENT:

Principal Scientific Officers, Scientific Officers, Grade I:

Duties.—To assist with the collection, collation and evaluation of research and development work in agriculture, fisheries and forestry, and application of results to development activities.

Qualifications.—A good honours degree in an agricultural, forestry or fisheries science. Higher degree will be an advantage. Suitable experience in research or related activity, 5 years for Principal Scientific Officers, 2 years for Scientific Officers, Grade I.

E. LIBRARY AND DOCUMENTATION UNIT:

Librarian Grade II|Library Officer, Assistant Library Officer:

Duties.—Acquisition, classification, cataloguing, indexing, abstracting, information storage and retrieval.

Qualifications.—For Librarian, a good degree in science and a diploma in librarianship or an equivalent qualification. F. Publication and Information Unit:

Assistant Chief Scientific Officer Principal Scientific (Editors):

Duties.—Will be responsible for the publication of National Journals of research in agriculture, engineering and technology, medical sciences and natural sciences; as well as other publications of the Agency.

Qualifications.—A good honours degree in physical biological, agricultural, engineering and medical sciences; post-graduate qualification in research or scientific journalism, and/or considerable experience in scientific editing and publication.

G. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT UNITS:

(i) Chief Accountant :

Duties.—The Chief Accountant will be responsible to the Executive Secretary for the efficient administration of the funds of the Agency. His duties will include:

- (i) establishment of an efficient accounting procedures and regulations;
- (ii) harmonizing and supervising accounting procedures in research institutes;
 - (iii) release of subventions and grants for research;
- (iv) assisting in preparing the budget for research, using programme budgeting.

Qualifications.—Membership of a recognised accounting body and at least 7 years post-qualification experience.

(ii) Principal Auditor:

Duties and Qualifications.—Principal Auditor will be in charge of the Audit Unit. He should be a member of a recognised accounting body and have at least 5 years post-membership experience in auditing.

- (iii) Senior Accountant, Senior Accountant (Audit).

 Qualifications.—Membership of a recognised accounting body and at least 3 years post-membership experience.
- (iv) Executive Officers (Accounts), Executive Officer (Audit), Assistant Executive Officer (Accounts), Assistant Executive Officer (Audit).—Appropriate qualification or experience on the-job.

H. ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT:

(i) Administrative Secretary:

Duties.—The Administrative Secretary will be responsible to the Executive Secretary for

- (a) internal administration of the Agency Secretariat;
- (b) supervision of the administrative units of Research Institutes to ensure compliance with appropriate regulations;

Qualifications.—A good university degree and at least 7 years administrative experience in a responsible position.

(ii) Senior Administrative Officers:
