(a) Pensionable Officers.—The posts are pensionable and in the case of a new entrant into the Public Service, appointment will normally be on probation for two years. Other conditions of service will be as prescribed for the time being for officers of equivalent grades in the Public of the Rivers State of Nigeria.

(b) Contract Officers (for Expatriates).—The conditions are similar to what obtains for officers of equivalent grades in the Public Service of the Rivers

- 7. Closing date.—Completed application forms should be submitted direct or through the appropriate channels to reach the Secretary, Public Service Commission, Port Harcourt, Rivers State of Nigeria, not later than 22nd August, 1977.
