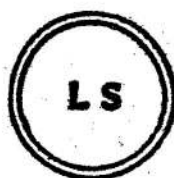

It is notified for the information of intending candidates that the competition for entry into the Administrative and Special Departmental Cadres of Auditors, Accountants, Assistant Registrars of Co-operative Societies, Produce Officers and Inspectors of Taxes, all in Grade Level 08, in the Oyo State of Nigeria Public Service will start in January 1978.

Only those candidates who attain the qualifying standard in the written examinations will be invited for the tests and interviews to be conducted by the Public Service Selection Board. The Public Service Commissioners will subsequently select, in the light of candidates' performance at the Selection Board, those whom they will themselves interview.

3. To be eligible for admission to the competition, a candidate who is not already a serving officer in the Oyo State of Nigeria Public Service must hold a Degree in either Arts, Social Sciences, Law, or Business Administration from a recognised university, or alternatively in the case of the Special Departmental Cadres of Auditors, Accountants and Inspectors of Taxes, a recognised professional qualification, i.e. the Final Certificate or Associate Membership of any of the following Professional Bodies :—

(i) Institute of Chartered Accountants ;

(ii) Association of Certified and Corporate Accountants ;

(iii) Institute of Cost and Management Accountants ;

(iv) Institute of Municipal Treasurers and Accountants.

*Note.*—(1) For the Special Departmental Cadre of Assistant Registrars of Co-operative Societies, a Degree in Economics is preferable and for the Cadre of Produce Officers, the Degree must be either in Agriculture or Economics. Holders of these degrees are not exempted from the written examination and the Extended Interviews.

(2) Candidates applying for the post of Auditor or Accountant who possess a good degree (either general with honours or distinction or special honours) in Accountancy or Economics with Accounts as the major subject, of a recognised university or any of the qualifications listed in paragraph 3 (i)-(iv) above are exempted from the written examination and the Extended Interviews mentioned in paragraph 2 (a) and (b) above, and need not pay the

₦12.00 fee mentioned in paragraph 6 below when submitting their applications. They will, however, be interviewed by the Public Service Commission.

(3) 'Recognised' in the above context means 'recognised by the Government of Oyo State of Nigeria.'

4. Candidates who are sitting for examinations in any of the above-mentioned qualifications in 1978 will also be eligible for admission into the competition on the understanding that if they fail to secure the appropriate qualifications, they will automatically drop out of the competition. University undergraduates who have to serve for one year in the compulsory National Youth Service Corps can participate in the competition but consideration for their appointment into any of the posts will, among other things, be subject to the production of a discharge certificate issued by the Directorate of the National Youth Service Corps.

5. The Written Examination will not be designed to test candidates on the subjects in which they hold degrees, but to test their ability to think clearly and to understand and write English and, also, their knowledge of current affairs, with particular reference to West African Affairs.

(i) *English (Precis and Critical Appreciation).*—This paper will consist of a precis of a passage supplemented by a question asking candidates to comment critically on the central idea of the passage.

(ii) *Current Affairs.*—This will be in two parts. Paper I will consist of three questions of the traditional Essay type, all of which must be answered. Paper II, an objective test, will consist of fifty questions, all of which must also be answered. In both papers, the range of questions will be such as will cater for the graduate, the university student as well as the non-graduate. The questions are intended to test the intelligent awareness of current affairs which any educated person may reasonably be presumed to possess.

(iii) *General.*—This will consist of two questions, one will test ability to detect dubious thinking and will contain short passages, the logical force of which is to be discussed critically. The other will test ability to draw statistical inferences from a table of numerical data.

6. The written examination will be held on 26th and 27th January, 1978 in Lagos, Ibadan, Ile-Ife, Zaria, Jos, London, Washington and at such other centres as may be determined later. Admission notices showing the necessary details including candidates' examination numbers will be sent direct to individual candidates by the West African Examinations Council. Each candidate will be required to pay an examination fee of ₦12.00 which is not refundable.

7. Serving Officers are being informed of the special arrangements affecting them. #### PROGRAMME FOR STRENGTHENING THE AGROMETEOROLOGICAL AND HYDROLOGICAL SERVICES OF THE SAHELIAN COUNTRIES AND ESTABLISHMENT OF A CENTRE FOR TRAINING AND APPLICATIONS OF AGROMETEOROLOGY/OPERATIONAL HYDROLOGY

The strengthening of National Services and the setting up of the Centre are among the medium-term and long-term measures intended to minimize the effects of climatological disasters and to improve the living conditions of the inhabitants of this area. The seven countries affected by the drought have set up a joint body in order to combine their efforts : the Permanent Inter-State Committee for Drought Control in the Sahel (CILSS). These countries are : the Gambia, Upper Volta, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Senegal and Chad.

The present Programme consists of :

Seven national projects intended to develop the

agrometeorological and hydrological observational networks, to strengthen services for data processing and providing users with short-term forecasts, and lastly, the training of technical personnel required for these tasks ;

A regional Centre to provide training for these personnel. This centre will subsequently have personnel and equipment for data processing on a regional basis.

Each national project comprises :

the services of an expert responsible for supervising meteorological and agrometeorological activities undertaken in the country ;

the supply of equipment for strengthening the networks ;

granting fellowships ;

hydrological activities undertaken under a sub-contract with ORSTOM (except the Gambia).

The Centre comprises :

the services of a Programme Co-ordinator responsible for the management and implementation of the entire Programme ;
