STATEMENT OF CLAIM

The Plaintiff is the person authorised by law to prosecute claims on behalf of the Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

2. The Defendant was, until the expiration of the life of Parliament on 16th January, 1966, a member of the House of Representatives in the Federal Parliament of Nigeria.

3. During his tenure of office as a Member of Parliament the Defendant applied to the United Dominion Corporation hereinafter referred to as the "U.D.C." for a loan to purchase a car No. LJ 1700 (hereinafter referred to as the "car") in consideration of the Federal Government (hereinafter called "the Government") agreeing to guarantee the repayment of the said loan which guarantee the Government gave.

4. By a letter dated 26th October, 1965, the United Dominion Corporation informed the Government that a loan of ₦3,280.50 had been approved for the Defendant repayable in 36 monthly instalments of ₦91.12 the first of which became payable on 30th November, 1965.

5. On his part the defendant entered into an Agreement with the Government sometimes in October 1965. The Plaintiff will rely on this Agreement at the trial.

6. The Defendant defaulted in the payment of the instalments and the Hire Purchase Agreement was terminated by the U.D.C.

7. A total sum of ₦2,885.36 which was outstanding against the Defendant as a result of the termination of the Hire-Purchase Agreement was paid to the U.D.C. by the Government as the guarantor of the defendant. The Plaintiff will rely at the trial on the U.D.C. letter dated 13th November, 1967 whereby the said payment by the Government was acknowledged.

8. By reason of the dissolution of the House of Representatives with effect from 16th January, 1966, the Defendant was overpaid a sum of ₦72.59.

9. Between 1973 and 1975 the Defendant paid ₦600.00 to the Government by various instalments out of the total debt of ₦2,957.95 leaving a balance of ₦2,357.95 unpaid.

10. The Plaintiff will at the trial rely on the Defendant's letters dated 2nd February, 1973, 20th March, 1973 and 30th May, 1973 with which he acknowledged his indebtedness to the Government.

11. The Defendant has refused to pay the sum of ₦2,357.95 which he owes to the Government in spite of repeated demands.

12. Whereof the Plaintiff claims the said sum of ₦2,357.95 with costs.

**OYO STATE OF NIGERIA PUBLIC SERVICE
COMPETITION FOR ENTRY INTO THE
ADMINISTRATIVE AND SPECIAL DEPARTMENTAL
CADRES OF THE OYO STATE OF
NIGERIA PUBLIC SERVICE, 1978**

It is notified for the information of intending candidates that the competition for entry into the Administrative and Special Departmental Cadres of Auditors, Accountants, Assistant Registrars of Co-operative Societies, Produce Officers and Inspectors of Taxes, all in Grade Level 08, in the Oyo State of Nigeria Public Service will start in January 1978.

2. The competition comprises :—

(a) a qualifying written examination, conducted by the West African Examinations Council ;

(b) a series of tests and interviews, known as Extended Interviews, conducted by the Public Service Selection Board ; and

(c) an interview before the Public Service Commission.

Only those candidates who attain the qualifying standard in the written examinations will be invited for the tests and interviews to be conducted by the Public Service Selection Board. The Public Service Commissioners will subsequently select, in the light of candidates' performance at the Selection Board, those whom they will themselves interview.

3. To be eligible for admission to the competition, a candidate who is not already a serving officer in the Oyo State of Nigeria Public Service must hold a Degree in either Arts, Social Sciences, Law, or

Business Administration from a recognised university, or alternatively in the case of the Special Departmental Cadres of Auditors, Accountants and Inspectors of Taxes, a recognised professional qualification, i.e. the Final Certificate or Associate Membership of any of the following Professional Bodies :—

(i) Institute of Chartered Accountants ;

(ii) Association of Certified and Corporate Accountants ;

(iii) Institute of Cost and Management Accountants ;

(iv) Institute of Municipal Treasurers and Accountants.

Note.—(1) For the Special Departmental Cadre of Assistant Registrars of Co-operative Societies, a Degree in Economics is preferable and for the Cadre of Produce Officers, the Degree must be either in Agriculture or Economics. Holders of these degrees are not exempted from the written examination and the Extended Interviews.

(2) Candidates applying for the post of Auditor or Accountant who possess a good degree (either general with honours or distinction or special honours) in Accountancy or Economics with Accounts as the major subject, of a recognised university or any of the qualifications listed in paragraph 3 (i)-(iv) above are exempted from the written examination and the Extended Interviews mentioned in paragraph 2 (a) and (b) above, and need not pay the ₦12.00 fee mentioned in paragraph 6 below when submitting their applications. They will, however, be interviewed by the Public Service Commission.

(3) 'Recognised' in the above context means 'recognised by the Government of Oyo State of Nigeria'.

4. Candidates who are sitting for examinations in any of the above-mentioned qualifications in 1978 will also be eligible for admission into the competition on the understanding that if they fail to secure the appropriate qualifications, they will automatically drop out of the competition. University undergraduates who have to serve for one year in the compulsory National Youth Service Corps can participate in the competition but consideration for their appointment into any of the posts will, among other things, be subject to the production of a discharge certificate issued by the Directorate of the National Youth Service Corps.

5. The Written Examination will not be designed to test candidates on the subjects in which they hold degrees, but to test their ability to think clearly and to understand and write English and, also, their knowledge of current affairs, with particular reference to West African Affairs.

(i) *English (Precis and Critical Appreciation).*—This paper will consist of a precis of a passage supplemented by a question asking candidates to comment critically on the central idea of the passage.

(ii) *Current Affairs.*—This will be in two parts. Paper I will consist of three questions of the traditional Essay type, all of which must be answered. Paper II, an objective test, will consist of fifty questions, all of which must also be answered. In both papers, the range of questions will be such as will cater for the graduate, the university student as well as the non-graduate. The questions are intended to test the intelligent awareness of current affairs which any educated person may reasonably be presumed to possess.

(iii) *General*.—This will consist of two questions, one will test ability to detect dubious thinking and will contain short passages, the logical force of which is to be discussed critically. The other will test ability to draw statistical inferences from a table of numerical data.

6. The written examination will be held on 26th and 27th January, 1978 in Lagos, Ibadan, Ile-Ife, Zaria, Jos, London, Washington and at such other centres as may be determined later. Admission notices showing the necessary details including candidates' examination numbers will be sent direct to individual candidates by the West African Examinations Council. Each candidate will be required to pay an examination fee of ₦12.00 which is not refundable.

7. Serving Officers are being informed of the special arrangements affecting them. Other candidates who have already applied for Form OYSPSC.1 for appointment to one or more of the posts mentioned in paragraph 1 above should, if in Nigeria, send to the Secretary, Public Service Commission, Treasury Receipt for the ₦12.00 competition fee (to be credited to Revenue Head 304, Sub-head 64 Public Service Examination Fees) or, if outside Nigeria, send an equivalent of ₦12.00 by crossed Money Order or Postal Order to the authority to whom they

addressed their applications on Form OYSPSC.1 under a covering letter referring to their applications. These must be received not later than *Friday, 7th October, 1977*. This Commission will not accept responsibility for money sent in any other manner than that prescribed and late entries will not be entertained.

8. Candidates who wish to sit for the examination should send the fee in the manner prescribed above, with fresh applications of Form OYSPSC.1, to the Secretary, Public Service Commission, Ibadan, if they are in West Africa, or to the Chairman, London Selection Panel and Recruitment Attaché, Nigeria High Commission, 9 Northumberland Avenue, London, W.C. 2 if they are in Europe, or to the Head of Chancery Embassy of Nigeria, 1333 Sixteenth Street, North West, Washington, D.C. 20036 if they are in the United States of America or Canada. The applications and fees must be received not later than *Friday, 7th October, 1977*.

The above salaries to which the appropriate allowances are added, may be subject to the following deductions :

Deductions.—1. 7 per cent of pensionable salary as contribution to the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, for staff members who take up employment under fixed-term contracts for one year or more.

2. Contribution, according to salary, to the Staff Mutual Accidents and Sickness Insurance (voluntary).

From 35 to 84 Swiss francs per month for an unmarried staff member ; and

From 99 to 239 Swiss francs per month for a married staff member (including children).

Allowances

1. **Post adjustment.**—The post adjustment which is an element of the total remuneration is not counted for pension purposes. It reflects the cost of living index at the duty station and also takes account of currency fluctuations, i.e. the parity changes between the US dollar and the Swiss franc. The figures shown are the annual amounts for one class of post adjustment. For example, as at 1st January, 1977, Geneva

was in class 12 2-5 and the corresponding post adjustments as of that date were therefore the above-mentioned amounts multiplied by 12.4.

2. **Dependency benefit.**—(a) US \$450 per year for each dependent child, except that the allowance shall not be paid in respect of the first dependent child if the staff member has no dependent spouse, in which case the staff member shall be entitled to the salary rates No. 1.

(b) Where there is no dependent spouse, a single annual allowance of US \$300 for either a dependent parent, a dependent brother or a dependent sister.

3. **Education grant.**—An education grant is paid under certain conditions for children attending a school or university.

Leave

1. **Annual leave.**—30 working days annually on full salary.

2. **Home leave.**—Paid once every two years for the staff member expected to remain in the Organization's services for not less than two years and six months. This provision extends to spouse and children recognized as dependants by the Organization.

3. **Sick leave.**—Staff members may under certain conditions be granted sick leave up to three months on full salary and three months on half salary in any period of twelve consecutive months.

Travel Expenses†

Staff members' travel expenses are reimbursed upon appointment and separation. Travel expenses for dependants, spouse and children, may be reimbursed provided that the staff member's appointment is for one year or more.

For all travel by a staff member or persons of his family, the staff member must obtain the Secretary-General's prior authorization in writing.

Removal expenses are also reimbursed upon arrival and departure, provided that the appointment is for two years or more.

A daily installation grant is paid to staff members arriving to take up their posts in Geneva, as follows :

(i) Staff member accompanied by his family—30 days at 117 Swiss francs for the staff member and 30 days at 58.50 Swiss francs each dependant.

(ii) Staff member arriving unaccompanied—15 days at 117 Swiss francs.

(iii) When the spouse and children arrive after the staff member, they receive the grant under paragraph (i) and the staff member himself receives for 15 days, from the time of their arrival, the sum of 117 Swiss francs per diem in addition to the amount paid to him under paragraph (ii).

Background information.—The Statistics Unit of the Research Service is headed by the Deputy Chief of the Research Service. The primary task of the Unit is the collection, checking, processing, analysis and publication of statistical data on international and domestic tourism from a large number of reporting countries including WTO's member States. The Unit is also involved in ongoing work on the harmonization of definitions and methods of collection so as to ensure the highest degree of international comparability between statistics of tourism. The Unit also prepares handbooks concerning the different aspects of the collection of domestic and international tourism statistics, including choice of sampling methods.

Description of duties.—Assists existing staff in all aspects of their permanent activities of gathering and analysing statistical information, in particular the checking and processing of incoming statistical data.
