NOTICE BY THE BOARD OF CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

Customs and Excise Notice No. 58

NEW CUSTOMS REVENUE DOCUMENTS

Commencement date : 1st November, 1977

1. Law—The attention of importers and licensed Customs Agents is invited to this Notice which is made under the powers conferred upon the Board by section 25 of the Customs and Excise Management Act No. 55 of 1958.

PART I—GENERAL

2. The following new Customs Revenue documents are introduced to be used for the relevant Customs transactions :—

(a) Form C.188—Import Entry for Home Use. This Form replaces Form Sale 42—Import Entry for Home Use, which was in use before.

(b) Form C.189—Entry for Warehousing, Ex-ship or Ex-Government Warehouse—in place of the former Sale 92—Entry for Warehouse, Ex-ship or Ex-Government Warehouse.

(c) Form C.190—Import Entry for Motor Vehicles. This Form is to be used exclusively for entering imported vehicles.

(d) Book C.66—Supplementary Release Book. This book is to be used for the subsequent release of packages which were placed on stop by Customs at the time part of the consignment was released on the Release Authority issued when the goods were originally examined.

(e) Book C.321—Customs Receipt. This book replaces Book C.303 (Customs Miscellaneous Receipt) ; Book C.306—Passenger's Duty Receipt—and Book C.304 (Auction Sale Receipt Book).

3. *Other Entry Forms* : The other Entry Forms listed in Annex "A" in Customs and Excise Notice No. 27 published as Government Notice No. 1928 of 1970 are still extant. These entry forms are not affected by the procedural changes arising from the introduction of the new Entry Forms mentioned above.

PART II—PRODUCTION AND SALE OF THE NEW ENTRY FORMS

4. The specifications of the new Entry Forms in terms of size, colour and ink impression have been standardised. Form C.188 (Import Entry for Home Use), Form C. 189 (Entry for Warehousing Ex-ship or Ex-Government Warehouse) and Form C.190 (Import Entry for Motor Vehicles) are to be exclusively produced by the Board of Customs and Excise and sold to licensed Customs Agents and importers. Entries have been produced in serially numbered books of 50 sets and are to be sold at the marked price of ₦14.00 each booklet. An official receipt on Book C.321 shall be issued by the proper officer for every sale. For security reasons, the Board of Customs and Excise is maintaining at every selling point, a permanent record of sale of these books in a Register which contains among other details the name and contact address of the buyer, quantity and serial number of book(s), etc. Copies of books of Entries are on sale at every Customs House in Nigeria.

5. As from 1st November, 1977, the old Entry forms and documents mentioned in paragraph 2 above shall no longer be accepted or used for any Customs transactions. Importers and licensed Customs agents are advised in their own interest to use the new Entry forms for the appropriate Customs transaction as any entries submitted with the old forms shall be rejected at the Import Control Seat.

6. Licensed Customs agents are expected to reflect in the bills for their services, the exact cost of the Entries used in clearing an importer's consignment. The Board reserves the right to revoke the licence of any agent who is known to be charging prices higher than what ought to be paid for a set of Entries.

PART III—OTHER CHANGES IN PROCEDURES CONCOMITANT WITH THE USE OF THE NEW ENTRY FORMS

7. The introduction of the new Entry Forms will give rise to some changes in Customs procedures for clearance of imported goods ;

(i) Six copies each of the Form C.188 (Import Entry for Home Use) and Form C.189 (Entry for Warehousing Ex-ship or Ex-Government Warehouse) and seven copies in the case of Form C.190 (Import Entry for Motor Vehicles) are now required to be submitted to Customs.

(ii) Invoices and other documents that should be submitted together with Entries are to be stapled to the back of the set of Entries and must not be inserted at the back of the original and duplicate copies of the Entry.

(iii) As from 1st November, 1977, a separate Customs Release Note—Form Sale 12 will not be required to be submitted with every set of Entry because one of the copies of the new Entry Forms has been designed to incorporate Customs and Nigerian Ports Authority/Nigeria Airways release/delivery requirements.

(iv) Supplementary Release Book—Book C.66 will be prepared by the proper Collector for the release of goods entered but either short released or short landed and subsequently produced or landed.

8. The new procedure for clearance of imported motor vehicles calls for special attention of importers and their licensed Customs agents ;

(a) Imported motor vehicles are to be exclusively entered on Form C.190 (Import Entry for motor vehicle).

(b) Only one model of vehicle (e.g. Peugeot 404 Saloon or Mercedes 200) irrespective of the number of vehicles of that model shall be entered on *one* Entry. It follows from this that one Invoice (in original and duplicate) is to be submitted for *one model* of vehicles together with Entry.

(c) In view of this requirement, importers and their licensed Customs agent are advised to obtain separate invoices for various models of vehicles if these models are to be shipped as one consignment.

(d) Importers and their licensed Customs agents are to note that any Entry on which more than one model of vehicle is entered shall be rejected at the Import Control Seat.

(e) Form C.191—Vehicle Duty Certificate which is the same as the vehicle card mentioned in paragraph (viii) of the Explanatory Notes contained in column 29 of the vehicle Entry (Form C.190) should be submitted at the time the vehicle is about to be released from Customs Control and one vehicle certificate is to be submitted for every motor vehicle.

(f) A vehicle Duty Certificate (Form C.191) will be issued in duplicate by the Customs to the importer or to the person/body entitled to duty free privileges in respect of every motor vehicle on which duty has been paid or on which exemption from payment of duty has been granted.

(g) After Customs authorisation, the importer or person/body entitled to duty free privileges will forward the two copies of the vehicle certificate to the Motor licensing/Registration Authority with his application for a Motor vehicle licence.

(h) The Second copy of the Vehicle Duty Certificate is to be returned subsequently to the Customs as indicated on that copy.

PART IV—AMENDMENTS OF RELEVANT CUSTOMS AND EXCISE NOTICES :

9. Amendments in the *Official Gazette* of the relevant Customs and Excise Notices affected by the procedural changes arising from the introduction of the new Revenue documents have been made. The Customs and Excise Notices affected by these amendments are :—

(i) Customs and Excise Notice No. 27 published as Government Notice No. 1928 of 1970.

(ii) Customs and Excise Notice No. 13 published as Government Notice No. 1989 of 1970.

Customs and Excise Notice No. 13 published as Government Notice No. 1989 of 1970 is hereby amended as follows :

1. Notes : (v)—At the end of the sentence in line 2, add the following new sentence, "But the new Entry Forms introduced with effect from 1st November, 1977 are to be exclusively produced by the Department of Customs and Excise and sold to importers or their licensed Customs agents at prices marked on the books of Entry Sets. Copies of books of Entries are on sale at every Customs House in Nigeria".

2. Paragraph 4 Delete and substitute a new paragraph as follows :—

"4 (1) Forms of Entry :"

3. Sub-paragraph 4 (a) Delete the sub-paragraph and substitute a new sub-paragraph (a) as follows :

"(a) New Entry Forms. With effect from 1st November, 1977 three new Entry Forms have been introduced for clearance of imported goods through the Customs—(see Annex "A" in Customs and Excise Notice No. 27 published as Government Notice No. 1928 of 1970 and as subsequently amended).

(i) Form C. 188—Import Entry for Home Use. Goods imported ex-ship, ex-aircraft or ex-motor vehicle for home use except as in sub-paragraphs (ii), (iii) and (b) below, are to be entered on Form C. 188—Import Entry for Home Use.

(ii) Form C. 189—Entry for Warehousing Ex-ship or Ex-Government Warehouse. Imported goods ex-ship, ex-aircraft, ex-motor vehicle or ex-Government Warehouse, which are liable to Customs duty may be entered on Form C. 189—Entry for Warehousing Ex-ship or Ex-Government Warehouse and warehoused without payment of the duty thereon provided that such goods are of the types normally permitted to be deposited in Warehouse. (See Customs and Excise Notice No. 10 published as Government Notice No. 699 of 1959 and as subsequently amended).

(iii) Form C. 190—Import Entry for Motor Vehicles. This Form is to be used exclusively for entering imported motor vehicles. One model of vehicle (e.g. Peugeot 404 Saloon or Mercedes 200) irrespective of the number of vehicles of that model may be entered on one Entry. Importers and their licensed Customs agents are therefore advised to obtain separate invoices for various models of vehicles if these models are shipped as one consignment. Any Entry on which more than one model of vehicle is entered shall be rejected at the Import Control Seat. The Vehicle Duty Certificate—Form C. 191 which is the same as the Vehicle Card mentioned in paragraph (viii) of the Explanatory Notes contained in column 29 of the Vehicle Entry (Form C. 190) should be submitted at the time the vehicle is about to be released and one vehicle certificate is to be submitted for every vehicle. (See Customs and Excise Notice No. 30 published as Government Notice No. 1974 in the Federation of Nigeria Official Gazette No. 57 Vol. 58 of 25th November, 1971 and as subsequently amended).

4. Sub-paragraph 4 (c) : (1) Heading—Delete the heading and substitute a new heading as follows :—

(c) "Goods entered but either short released or short landed and subsequently produced or landed".

(ii) Line 4—After the last word and the full stop in line 4, add a new sentence as follows :

"A supplementary Release Book—Book C 66 will be prepared by the proper Collector for the release of such goods".

(See Customs and Excise Notice No. 27 published as Government Notice No. 1928 of 1970 and as subsequently amended).

5. Add a new paragraph 4 (ii) as follows :—"4 (ii) Sale and Production of the New Entry Forms. The new Entry Forms namely, Form C. 189 and Form C. 190, are to be exclusively produced by the Board of Customs and Excise and sold to importers and or licensed Customs agents. Books of Entries each containing 50 sets of Entry Form may be purchased by authorised buyers at the marked price at any Customs House in Nigeria. An official receipt on Book C 321 (see specimen at Annex 'R' to this Notice) is to be issued by the proper officer for every sale.

6. Paragraph 5. *Delete* the paragraph and *substitute* a new paragraph as follows :—

"5 Number of copies of Entry Forms. (a) New Entry Forms :—

(i) Six copies each of the Entries for Home Use (Form C. 188) and for Warehousing (Form C. 189) and seven copies in the case of the Entry for Motor Vehicles (Form C. 190) are to be submitted. All copies of Entries are to be machine stamped.

(ii) After passing, the sixth or seventh copy of the Entry, as the case may be will be, handed over by the cashier to the importer or his licensed Customs agent as an official receipt. Since a separate "Exchange Control Copy" is provided under the new Entry Forms, the importer's copy of the Entry cannot therefore be accepted for Exchange Control purposes.

(b) Other Entry Forms. (See Annex "A" in Customs and Excise Notice No. 27 published as Government Notice No. 1928 of 1970 and as subsequently amended).

(i) In the meantime four copies of the other Entry Forms should continue to be submitted. These copies will all be machine stamped by the cashier who is to hand over the fourth copy to the importer or his licensed Customs agent as an official receipt.

(ii) In the case of these other Entry Forms, the importer's copy of the Entry will continue to be acceptable for exchange control purposes. Importers and their licensed Customs agents are however warned that such copy of the Entry must not be endorsed with the remark "FOR EXCHANGE CONTROL PURPOSE". Any copy so endorsed shall be rejected.

7. Paragraph 6 (a)—At the end of the first sentence of the sub-paragraph, *add* a new sentence as follows :—
"Importers and or licensed Customs agents are requested to use good carbon papers in preparing Entries in order to ensure that the details type-written on the Entries appear clearly on all the copies."

8. Paragraph 6 (b)—At the end of the existing sentence of the sub-paragraph, *add* a new sentence as follows :—

"In the light of the requirement that only one model of vehicle irrespective of the number of vehicles of that model must be entered on *one* Entry, importers are therefore advised to obtain separate invoices for various models of vehicles if these models are shipped as one consignment".

9. Paragraph 8 (a) (ii) Number of copies—At the end of the sentence in line 2, *add* the following sentences :

"In respect of motor vehicles, one invoice (in original and duplicate) is to be submitted for one model of vehicle irrespective of the number of vehicles of that model. If various models of vehicles are to be shipped as one consignment, importers or their licensed Customs agents must obtain separate invoices to cover each model of vehicle."

10. Paragraph 8 (d)—*Delete* the sub-paragraph and *substitute* a new sub-paragraph as follows :

"8 (d) Release Note : (i) New Entry Forms. A separate Form Sale 12—Customs Release Note is not required to be submitted with copies of the new Entry Forms as one of the copies of the Entry has been designed to incorporate Customs release requirements.

(ii) Other Entry Forms : Form Sale 12—Customs Release Note will continue to be submitted with every set of the other Entry Forms.

11. New sub-paragraph for paragraph 8 : At the end of sub-paragraph 8 (e) *add* a new sub-paragraph 8 (f) as follows :—

8 (f) Importers or their licensed Customs agents are to ensure that in submitting Entries to the Customs invoices and other documents that should be submitted together with Entries must be *stapled together to the back of the set of Entries*. These documents must not be inserted at the back of the original and duplicate copies of Entries before submission.

3. Delete paragraph 2 and substitute new paragraph 2 as follows :—

"2 (i) New Entry forms. The specifications of the new Entry forms in terms of size, colour and ink impression have been standardised. The new Entry forms, namely form C. 188 (Import Entry for home use), Form C. 189 (Entry for Warehousing Ex-ship or ex-Government Warehouse) and Form C. 190—(Import Entry for Motor Vehicles) are exclusively to be produced by the Board of Customs and Excise and sold to importers or their licensed Customs agents at prices marked on the books of Entry Forms. Books of Entries may be purchased by authorised buyers and an official receipt on Book C. 321 issued by the proper officer for every sale. Six copies each of forms C. 188 and C. 189 and seven copies of form C. 190 are required to be submitted to the Customs for passing.

(ii) Other Entry forms :

(a) Size—The remaining Entry Forms listed in Annex 'A' are to be printed on good quality paper preferably woven paper of reasonable thickness and must be of 295mm x 295mm (11½" x 11½") in dimension.

(b) Colour : Four copies of any of these other Entry Forms will continue to be submitted for passing and they must be of the following colours :

(i) Originals.....White

(ii) Duplicates.....Pink

(iii) Triplicates.....Light Green ; and

(iv) Quadruplicates.....Deep Yellow

(c) Ink Impression :—All Entry Forms must be printed.

(iii) Other requirement of Entry Forms :—

(a) Particulars to be furnished ; All particulars furnished on the copies of Entries must be type-written.

(b) Invoice dimension :—Invoices attached to Entry Forms for submission to the Customs must be of the size of 295mm x 203mm (11½" x 8") and should contain such particulars as can be conveniently declared in the space provided in the Entry. Importers and their licensed Customs Agents are enjoined to bear this requirement in mind as continuation Entries will not be accepted."

4. Delete paragraph 3 and substitute a new paragraph 3 as follows :—

"3 Effective date of introduction of the new Revenue Documents. The new Revenue Documents specified in Annex "A" shall be introduced into use with effect from the date of this Notice. Any Entry Forms or Revenue Documents which do not comply with the specifications in Annexes 'B' to 'Y' shall be rejected."

After Customs authorisation the relevant Vehicle Duty Certificate (see paragraph 9 below) shall be handed over to the importer or his licensed Customs agent for transmission to the Motor licensing Authority where the vehicle will be registered.

2. Sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of Paragraph 2 :—Delete the reference to Form Sale 42 in sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) and substitute in each case, "Form C. 190".

3. Paragraph 9 :—(i) Delete the heading of the paragraph and substitute the following, "Issue of Vehicle Duty Certificates on Motor Vehicles" : (ii) Line 2—Delete the expression, "one of the following certificates" and substitute the following "a Vehicle Duty Certificate, Form C. 191.

4. Sub-paragraphs (a)—(c) of paragraph 9 :—Delete the three sub-paragraphs and substitute the following sub-paragraphs:

(a) At the time of importation and before release from official control, the Department of Customs and Excise will issue a Vehicle Duty Certificate Form C. 191 (Annex B) in duplicate to the importer or to the person/body entitled to duty free privileges in respect of every motor vehicle on which duty has been paid or on which exemption from payment of duty has been granted. After Customs authorisation, the importer or person/body entitled to duty free privileges will forward the two copies of the certificates to the Motor Registration/Licensing Authority with his application for a motor vehicle Licence. One copy (lower portion) is to be returned to the customs by the Licensing Authority after registration.

(b) Conditions for issue of Vehicle Duty Certificates for Motor Vehicle Exempted from payment of duty. A vehicle Duty Certificate shall be issued in respect of :

(i) A Motor Vehicle imported without payment of duty under specific provisions in the Tariff ; and

(ii) for a motor vehicle purchased by privileged person or body from the duty paid stock of an agent in Nigeria with the prior approval in writing of the Board, provided the Agent surrenders to the Board the duty certificate issued at the time of importation of the vehicle.

(iii) In the case where a vehicle is purchased from the duty paid stock of an agent by a diplomat the certificate shall be issued by the proper Area Chief Collector at the time such collector approves Form C. 111 (Request for Customs clearance of vehicles for the Diplomatic Corps/Technical Assistant Personnel in Nigeria) ;

(iv) In the case of purchase of a vehicle from duty paid stock of an agent by Technical Assistant Personnel, the certificate shall be issued at Headquarters by the Chief Collector, Privileged Importations and Trade Concessions (CC/PITC), after approving the purchase at the time of issue of the relevant vehicle Replacement Authorisation".

5. Paragraphs 10, 14, 15, and 16—Delete all references to Form C. 50 or C. 51 and Book C. 50 or Book C. 51 and substitute "Form C. 191".

Government Notice No. 1328**BUREAU FOR EXTERNAL AID FOR EDUCATION
OVERSEAS SCHOLARSHIPS, 1978-79****FOREIGN AID PROGRAMME**

Policy.—It is the policy of the Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria to accept scholarships outside Nigeria at institutions of higher education that will provide supplementary facilities to those available in this country and which will support the high-level manpower policy of the Federal Republic.

During the course of the year, scholarship offers are made to Nigeria by various foreign Governments. All offers must as a matter of policy be made to the Nigerian Government in the first instance through the Ministry of External Affairs which then passes them to the Bureau for External Aid for Education for evaluation and processing.

Fields.—In support of this policy overseas scholarships are expected to be available at :—

- (i) Post-graduate level in all fields
 - (ii) Undergraduate level and
 - (iii) Technical/Vocational level
- { in areas of priority as may be determined from time to time in consultation with the Manpower Board and those for which local facilities are inadequate. Generally, however, these are mainly courses in Agriculture, Engineering, Metallurgy, Architecture, Medicine/Public Health, Science, Mathematics, Economics, Foreign Languages.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS :

Post-graduate Students.—All applicants for post-graduate scholarships must possess a good first degree, preferably a first or a second-class. Applicants who are previous recipients of foreign awards must have completed at least two years post-qualifications employment or practice in Nigeria. A working knowledge of the foreign language of the donor country is desirable.

Undergraduate.—All applicants for undergraduate, degree courses must possess the HSC/GCE 'A' level or a Division One School Certificate, or GCE 'O' level in at least six subjects, including English and Mathematics. Preference would normally be given to candidates with HSC/GCE 'A' levels. In all cases, candidates must have principal level passes or at least 'credit passes' in subjects relevant to their fields.

Vocational/Technical Courses.—Applicants for Vocational/Technical courses must possess at least a Grade III School Certificate with Credits in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and/or Biology. Candidates with City and Guilds, Trade Test Certificates and similar qualifications must in addition show that they possess at least a Grade III School Certificate with credits or their equivalents in Mathematics and Physics.

Students currently enrolled in higher institutions in Nigeria should apply and submit their forms through their institutions for French-Language one-year-Abroad and USA-AFGRAD awards programmes at such a time as the Bureau will direct for each of the programmes. Except for the above, students already enrolled for degree, technical and vocational courses in Nigerian institutions are NOT expected to apply for scholarships tenable outside the country.

Method of application for application forms.

1. Only those candidates who possess the basic qualifications as specified above should apply for application forms.

Ikoyi, Lagos. For prospective applicants outside Nigeria, the application letter should be mailed to the nearest Nigerian Embassy or Consulate Office Overseas.
