- (c) Agricultural Co-operative Officers (Rural Sociology), Grade I.—The incumbents will assist in matters pertaining to rural sociology, including problems relating to land tenure. They will also assist in determining, through appropriate methods, the requirements of agricultural production schemes under review by the Division, in terms of human potential, value systems and patterns of social organisations, etc. They will be expected to perform such other duties within their professional competence as may be required from time to time by their Divisional head.

- (d) Agricultural Co-operative Officers, Grade I (Statistics and Research).—They will assist in the collection and classification and analysis of statistics relating to agricultural Co-operative development. They will also assist in the conduct of Co-operative research required for the purpose of the agricultural Co-operative programmes.
- (e) Agricultural Co-operative Officers (Credit, Savings and Banking), Grade I,—They will assist in all matters pertaining to Agricultural Co-operative Credit, Savings and Banking; They will also assist in determining Co-operative Credit and Savings requirements of Agricultural production schemes, and assist in the organisation and conduct of special training courses for Government and private Co-operative staff in the administration of Agricultural Credit schemes.
- (f) Agricultural Co-operative Officers (Supply, Storage, Marketing and Processing), Grade II.—
  They will assist in all matters pertaining to Co-operative supply of production requisites and storage, marketing and processing of Agricultural produce. They will help in the formulation of policies and programmes on supply of farm input, storage, marketing and processing of Agricultural produce.
- (g) Agricultural Co-operative Officers (Rural Sociology), Grade II.—They will assist in all matters pertaining to rural Sociology. They will also help in the formulation of policies and programmes on supply of farm input.
- (h) Agricultural Co-operative Officers (Statistics and Research), Grade II.—They will assist in all matters pertaining to rural sociology. They will also help in the formulation of policies and programmes on supply of farm input.
- (h) Agricultural Co-operative Officers (Statistics and Research), Grade II.—They will assist in all matters pertaining to collection and classification and analysis of Statistics relating to agricultural co-operative development. They will aslo help in the formulation of policies.
- (i) Agricultural Co-operative Officers (Credit, Savings and Banking), Grade II.—They will assist in all matters pertaining to agricultural Co-operative Credit, Savings and Banking.
- (j) Agricultural Co-operative Officers (Supply, Storage, Marketing and Processing) Grade II.—
  They will assist in all matters pertaining to Co-operative production requisites and storage, marketing and processing of Agricultural Produce. They will also assist in formulation of policies and programmes on storage, marketing and processing of Agricultural produce.
- 5. Conditions of service.—The posts are pensionable and new entrants to the Public Service will normally be on probation for two years, other conditions of service will be as prescribed for the time being for officers of equivalent grades in the Federal Public Service. If government quarters are provided, rent will be payable at 81 per cent of the basic salary subject to a maximum of 300.00 per annum.
