RATE OF ROYALTY ON TIN

For the purpose of computing Royalty on Tin during the period 14th December, 1977 to 13th January, 1978 the average mean price of tin during the month ended 30th November, 1977 was N8230.8964

- 2. The Royalty payable will therefore be N1,316.9434 per metric ton of metallic tin in concentrate. Tin Ore shall be deemed to contain not less than 72.5 per cent of Metallic Tin.
- 3. Attention is drawn to regulation 78 (2) of the Minerals Regulations. Every producer of tin ore shall forward to the Deputy Director of Mineral Resources relevant authenticated account sales not later than six months from the date on which the tin ore was exported or delivered to the smelters.
