ASSISTANT TO THE NATIONAL HYDROLOGICAL
SERVICE AND DEVELOPMENT OF HYDROLOGICAL
BASINS IN CENTRAL GUINEA

The Government of Guinea has undertaken to complete the efforts it has already made by developing hydrological networks and the operational infrastructure capable of operating these networks and also to study the data already collected by integrating these activities within a national Hydrological Service and providing the personnel and equipment necessary for carrying out this task satisfactorily. The government has decided to request the assistance of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) to back up their efforts.

The duration of the project will be five years during which time the national Hydrological Service will be set up. The international team of experts consists of a Project Manager and an expert in operational hydrology. Specialists in various fields will be attached to this nucleus for shorter terms and will take part in setting up certain specialized functions of the future Service. Under the project, provisions is

further made for the study of the hydrological development of one of the natural regions of the country which will be carried out by sub-contract.

The training of a sufficient number of personnel in the Hydrological Service is an important aspect of the project. Provision is made for training abroad a certain number of hydrological engineers by means of fellowships. Training courses will be organized locally to provide basic training for technicians. The expert of the project will play a large part in this training which will be provided jointly with instructors from Guinea.

The project makes provision for the supply of a large amount of material ranging from means of transport, through hydrometric, telecommunication and office equipment.
