#### DESCRIPTION

All that strip of land approximatley 5.374 kilometres (3.359 miles) long, situate within the Bonny Local Government Area of the Rivers State the route of which traverses dry land and seasonal swamp and is shown in red in the Licensee's Drawing No. 55184 dated November 1977 and which encloses the proposed 6" Bonny Gasline. The width of the said strip of land will be variable and will be approximately as follows :

(a) where the route traverses dry land—15.25m (50 ft).

(b) where the route traverses seasonal swamp— 15.25m (50 ft).

(c) in the vicinity of all points of intersection (PI's)-15.25m (50 ft).

Where in the following text the bearing of the line is described as proceedings to a certain PI, the line will follow a simple curve from a tangent point before the PI and will enter the next bearing at a tangent point after the PI, the exact distance from tangent point to tangent point will vary according to the radius of the curve used.
