## Oil Pipelines Act (Cap. 145) 1965 APPLICATION FOR OIL PIPELINE LICENCE

Notice is hereby given in accordance with section 8 of the Oil Pipeline Act 1965 (Cap. 145) that the Nigerian National Petroleum Corporation, whose registered office is at Six-Storey Building, Broad Street, Lagos has applied for the grant of a licence to enter upon, take possession of and use for a period of twenty (20) years a strip of land for the purpose of laying a 12" O.D. pipeline from Ikorodu Terminal to a tie-in point on the proposed Ibadan to Ikorodu pipeline. This strip of land is in Ogun State. The route is demarcated on the ground with pillars in concrete and hereinunder described.
