

INTERPRETATION OF SOME IMPORTANT EXPRESSIONS USED IN THE NIGERIAN ENTERPRISES PROMOTION DECREE, 1977

The Nigerian Enterprises Promotion Board has, of recent, received some enquiries or representations which touch on the meaning of some important expressions used in the Nigerian Enterprises Promotion Decree, 1977. It is, therefore, hereby notified for the information of the public in general and the business community in particular that in accordance with Section 23 of the Nigerian Enterprises Promotion Decree No. 3, 1977 (and Section 16 of the Nigerian Enterprises Promotion Decree No. 4, 1972) the following important expressions have the meanings respectively assigned to them :

(i) "The equity participation of Nigerian citizens or associations" in affected enterprises refers to stocks and shares which Nigerian citizens or associations have in such enterprises which do not bear fixed interest or dividend.

(ii) A "Nigerian citizen or association" means-

(a) a person who is a citizen of Nigeria by virtue of the Constitution of the Federation ;

(b) any person of African descent, not being a citizen of Nigeria, who is a national of any country in Africa which is a member country of the Organisation of African Unity, and who continues to reside and carry on business in Nigeria, if the country of which he is a national also permits citizens of Nigeria to establish and operate businesses or enterprises in that country on the basis of reciprocity; and

(c) any company registered under the Companies Decree 1968, partnership, association or body (whether corporate or unincorporate), and except as otherwise prescribed under the Decree, the entire capital or other financial interest of which is owned wholly and exclusively by citizens of Nigeria.

(*iii*) An "Alien" means a person or association whether corporate or unincorporate other than a Nigerian citizen or association.

2. Based on the above definitions and for the purposes of the Decree, the following conclusions emerge :--

(i) Shares and stocks in affected alien enterprises which bear fixed interest or dividend could not be treated as forming part of the stipulated mandatory equity participation of Nigerian citizens or associations.

(ii) The special dispensation being granted to nationals of member countries of the Organisation of African Unity under the Decree is limited to persons of African descent only.

(iii) For any association to qualify as a "Nigerian association," its entire capital or other financial interest must be owned wholly and exclusively by citizens of Nigeria." . 3. Persons making any representations to the Board on any matters relating to the above are therefore advised to ensure that they adhere strictly to the interpretations or definitions given above.

PROGRAMME AND TIME-TABLE FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE NIGERIAN ENTERPRISES PROMOTION DECREE, 1977

In order to ensure that all affected alien enterprises. comply with the provisions of the Decree not later than the stipulated date of 31st December, 1978, all alien enterprises that have so far not complied with the provisions of the Decree are required to note and observe the following :

(i) All affected alien enterprises or shares of such enterprises are to be valued as at 29th June, 1976 or the next end-of-year account's date up to and including 31st December, 1977.

(ii) All affected alien enterprises are required to submit their applications for valuation to the Capital Issues Commission, including all necessary documents, so as to reach the Commission not later than 30th June, 1978.

(iii) All affected alien enterprises that are being operated otherwise than by or as a Public Company are requested, except if otherwise specifically directed by the Board, to ensure that they submit their list of prospective buyers so as to reach the Board not later than 30th June, 1978.

2. Affected alien enterprises are advised to note that because of the rigorous procedure required for compliance, which include valuation by the Capital Issues Commission and approval of proposals for compliance including allotment of shares either by the Board or the Allotment Committee and the fact that about 900 alien enterprises are still to comply with the provisions of the Decree, enterprises which do not observe the above directives would not be able to comply by the stipulated date.

3. Affected enterprises are warned that no extension of time will be granted to any enterprise. Enterprises which fail to comply with the provisions of the Decree by the stipulated date of 31st December, 1978, will be regarded as defaulters. Such enterprises would be taken over and disposed of as stipulated under the Decree.

(iii) Membership of the Institute of Cost and Management Accountants;

(iv) Membership of the Institute of Municipal Treasurers and Accountants ;

(v) An Honours University Degree in Accountancy or Business Administration or Economics with Accountancy as special subject.

In addition to any of the qualifications listed in (i)-(r) above, applicants must not be less than 30 years of age and must have at least 10 years' post-qualification experience at Senior Management Level in Government, Statutory Corporations or State-owned Companies.

4. Duties.—Successful candidate will be the Chief Accounting Officer of the State Government and will control cash and investments, all Agency Accounts and the Accounting Division of the Ministry of Finance and Economic Development.
