INCOMES POLICY GUIDELINES 1978-79

The Federal Military Government has directed the implementation of the Guidelines on wages and salaries, fringe benefits, professional incomes, dividends and prices for the 1978-79 financial year. Accordingly, pursuant to Section 4 (5) of Decree No. 30 of 1977, the Productivity, Prices and Incomes Board hereby gives the following Public Notice :—

A. Professional Incomes Guidelines :

(i) The remunerations (i.e. fees, allowances and other perquisites whether in cash or kind) of non-executive members of Boards in both private and public sectors may not be increased during the period 1st April, 1978 to 31st March, 1979.

(ii) Remunerations paid to non-executive Board members whether in the public or private sector should be taxed at source.

(iii) The Government's rates for professional services, such as those provided by Architects, Estate Managers, Engineers-civil, mechanical and electrical, Quantity Surveyors are hereby reaffirmed and made fully applicable throughout the economy, i.e. in both the public and private sectors.

(iv) For the accounting and auditing sub-sectors, in no case should the sum of all fees and all charges paid in any public or private sector organisation for contracted services, in the new financial year, be higher than in the preceding one.

(v) Fixed fees, charges or retainers paid by public and private sector organisations to professional firms and self-employed professionals should not be higher than in the preceding financial year.

(vi) The payment of fees, charges and the incurring of total expenses higher than those implied in (iii)-(v) above will not be accepted by the Inland Revenue Department as expenses for tax purposes.

B. Dividend Guidelines :

(i) During the period 1st April, 1978 to 31st March, 1979, dividends up to "40 per cent gross" may be declared and distributed. Such dividends are to be calculated on the same basis as during the 1977/78 financial year.

(ii) Scrips based on increases in reserves related to revaluation of assets continue to be forbidden.

(iii) To facilitate processing of applications for tax purposes or foreign remittances, etc. companies should in addition to the usual information, submit, to the relevant authorities, the following :

(a) Equity capital as at 30th September, 1976 ;

(b) Scrips issued from 1st October, 1976 :— give specific dates and amounts.

(c) Changes in Equity Capital since 30th September 1976—give specific dates of changes and indicate increases not due to scrip issues.

(d) Total dividends distributed in 1976/77, 1977/78 and 1978/79 financial years.

(e) Reserves.

C. Price Guidelines :

(i) Importers of all machinery for resale should not apply a mark-up of more than 25% to the landing cost. Other local costs such as import duty and clearing charges, etc. should be added after that to arrive at the selling price of the machinery.

(ii) The rates charged for advertisement in the media as well as fees and commissions charged by Advertisement Agencies shall not be increased during the period 1st April, 1978 to 31st March, 1979.

(iii) Increases in prices should be effected or allowed where it is shown that increases in costs cannot be absorbed by a company without undesirable consequences to it.

D. Wages, Salaries and Fringe Benefits :

There shall be no general increase in pay during the 1978-79 financial year. However, Government has set up a Panel consisting of representatives of all relevant interests in the public and private sectors to advise it on how to provide welfare relief to workers.

E. Certification :

Auditors' reports on companies and other institutions must contain statements as to whether or not the provisions of the Incomes Policy Guidelines, as specified above, have been adhered to in every respect.

F. Penalty :

Failure to comply with the provisions of the guidelines will be punished under section 5 (2) of Decree No. 30. of 1977.
