In addition to the above documentary evidence, applicants are enjoined to request their bankers to send directly to this Office a report on their credit worthiness and main line of business.

3. Applicants are reminded to indicate the amount they require for each specific item for which they are applying. The business or registered address of the applicant should be stated. Post Office Box or Private Mail Bag numbers will NOT be accepted.
