Customs and Excise No. 13A

AMENDMENT OF CUSTOMS AND EXCISE NOTICE No. 13 Published as Government Notice No. 1989 of 1970

The Customs and Excise Notice No. 13 (which relates to the "Entry Ex-Ship, Ex-Aircraft or Ex-Motor of Imported goods for Home Use") is hereby amended as follows:-

(i) after sub-paragraph (f) of paragraph 3 thereof, there shall be added the following two new sub-para-

- (g) Free House: means the delivery of imported goods to a warehouse in Nigeria with all charges paid up to that warehouse. The value of goods for duty purposes is the total cost of those goods at the time of arrival at the first port or place of importation in Nigeria.
- (h) Free at Frontier: means the delivery of imported goods through a frontier station to a warehouse in Nigeria with all charges paid up to that warehouse. The value of any such goods for duty purposes is the total cost of those goods at the time of arrival at the frontier station :
- (ii) for Annex 'D"-Form Sale 123, there shall be substituted the new Annex "D"-Form Sale 123 set out in Schedule 1 to this Notice; and
- (iii) for Annex "E"-Form Sale 124, there shall be substituted the new Annex "E"-Form Sale 124 set out in Schedule 2 to this Notice.
