Customs and Excise Notice No. 60

NOTICE BY THE BOARD OF CUSTOMS AND EXCISE  
IMPORTATION OF GOODS IN CONTAINERS

## GENERAL

1. *Laws.*—(a) The laws governing the control of imported goods for home use are contained in Sections 17, 25 to 28, 29 and 35 to 42 of the Customs and Excise Management Act No. 55 of 1958.

(b) The attention of importers and their agents and all others concerned is drawn to Sections 43, 44 and 142 of the same Act which prescribes appropriate penalties.

2. *Purpose.*—This notice contains the requirements of the Board of Customs and Excise in respect of the control of the importation of goods in containers, for home use ; in transit and transshipment. It considers the operation of container depots outside the ports. Nothing in this Notice is, in any way, to be presumed to amend the existing law.

## DEFINITIONS

3. In this Notice :

(a) "Container" means an article of transport equipment such as lift-van, movable tank or other similar structure—

- (i) fully or partially enclosed to constitute a compartment intended for containing goods ;
- (ii) of a permanent or semi-permanent character and accordingly strong enough to be suitable for repeated use ;
- (iii) specially designed to facilitate the carriage of goods by one or more modes of transport, without intermediate reloading or packing ;
- (iv) designed for ready handling, particularly when being transferred from one mode of transport to another ;
- (v) designed to be easy to fill and to empty and ;
- (vi) having an internal volume of one cubic metre or more.

For the purpose of this sub-paragraph a "Container" shall include the accessories and equipment of the container, appropriate for the type concerned, provided that such accessories and equipment are carried with the container. The term "Container" shall not include vehicles, accessories or spare parts of vehicles.

(b) "Container Area" is a place designated as such by the Port Administering Authority for the landing or Containers for Customs purposes.

(c) A Container depot shall be a place so designated and licensed by the Board of Customs and Excise.

(d) Container Depot Operator means any person, firm or body corporate administering a container depot for Customs purposes and who has effective control of the container, its use, removal or otherwise ;

(e) "Internal traffic" shall mean the carriage of goods loaded at one Nigerian Customs ports, airport or station for unloading at another port, Airport or station or any place or Container Depot designated by the Board ;

(f) Containers in Transit : Imported containers which are reported in transit at an approved port or place and which are entered by the owner or his agent as in transit through Nigeria by an approved route price to their release from Customs Control ;

(g) Transshipment Containers—are containers imported into Nigeria by Sea or Air and destined for immediate re-exportation by Sea or Air to a place outside Nigeria. They include containers destined for a foreign port or place but landed in error in Nigeria and the container which the importer wishes to return to the Country of origin prior to release from Customs Control. They do not include containers destined for another Port or place in Nigeria.

#### 4. APPROVAL OF BONDED CONTAINER DEPOTS

(a) The approval of bonded container depots shall be subject to the provisions of Customs and Excise Notice No. 9 of 1959.

(b) A Container Depot may be licensed as a General Bonded Warehouse, subject to the Warehouse Keeper/Container operator executing the following three bonds.

(i) General Bond for the Carriage of goods subject to Customs Control (Form C. 176).

(ii) General Bond for the Warehousing of goods and removal of Warehoused goods (Form C. 171).

(iii) Bond for the re-exportation of empty containers imported without payment of duty (Form C. 170).

#### 5. MANIFESTS FOR CONTAINERS :

(a) Separate manifests of containers are to accompany the ship's report ;

(b) goods for each station or depot are to be shown separately on the manifest ;

(c) containers shall be properly identified with individual marks and numbers and are to be so manifested ;

(d) each package in the container shall be clearly identified with the importer's marks and number ;

(e) the quantity and description of goods in each container shall be shown on the manifest ;

(f) the name and physical address (in addition to P.O. Box or P.M.B. if any) of the consignee of the goods shall also be shown on the manifest.

#### 6. LANDING AND LOADING OF CONTAINERS

(a) Containers, whether loaded with goods or not, are to be landed or loaded at any of the approved Customs Ports, Customs Airports or Container Depot having facilities for the custody, handling and examination of containers and the goods contained in them.

(b) Containers shall be landed or loaded securely locked bearing the seal of the exporting Country.

(c) The concession for direct delivery of goods specified in paragraph 20 of Customs and Excise Notice 13 Government Notice No. 1989 of 1970 shall not apply in respect of goods imported in Containers.

#### 7. ENTRY OF GOODS IMPORTED IN CONTAINERS

(a) Goods imported in Containers shall be entered in accordance with the provisions of Government Notice No. 1989 of 1970—Customs and Excise Notice No. 13.

(b) Invoices in respect of container goods (see paragraph 8 of Customs and Excise Notice No. 13) attached to Entries for Home Use shall contain full description, value and quantity of the goods imported in Containers.

#### 8. EXAMINATION OF CONTAINERS

(a) Goods imported in a Container shall be homogeneous. Any container carrying goods shall be accompanied by a packing list certified by the producer, manufacturer, supplier or exporter, showing all the items imported in the Container. Any container carrying heterogeneous goods may be subject to 100 per cent examination by proper Officer.

(b) Containers which are to be cleared from Customs Control within the Port area shall be landed in a special area designated "Container Area". The Port Administering Authority is to provide the "Contains Area" within the Customs Area for purpose of Customs examination.

(c) Containers for transfer to bonded Container Area outside the Port Area are to be sealed before transfer is effected. The seal will remain intact until inspected by the proper officer and examination of goods ordered.

#### 9. TRANSFER OF CONTAINERS TO CONTAINER DEPOTS

(a) The provisions of Customs and Excise Notice No. 9 shall apply with such modifications as local conditions may dictate.

(b) In addition to specified Customs procedures relating to the handling of goods generally, the following procedures shall also apply to container goods ;

(i) The content of any container shall not be off-loaded in any place other than in a place so provided for that purpose within the bonded area.

(ii) The off-loading of the content of a container shall be in the presence of a proper officer.

- (iii) The seal and lock on a container shall be broken only by a proper Customs Officer.
- (iv) The container shall not be opened for examination unless the goods have been entered.
- (v) A transfer note shall be used to transfer a container out of Customs Area to an inland container depot.
- (vi) Release of container goods in a depot should be effected on a home use entry in accordance to Customs and Excise Notice No. 30.
- (c) Container may be discharged direct into rail wagons, vans, road trailer, etc. for transfer out of a Customs Area to Inland Container depots on Container depots on Container Goods Permit Form C. 194 (see Annex "A") and Inland Depot Transfer Form Sale 43A (see Annex "B") in triplicate for Warehousing. The relevant provisions of customs and Excise Notice No. 8 of 1959 shall apply.

#### 10. NOTES ON CONTAINERS TRAFFIC

(a) Containers imported in transit or for transshipment shall not be deemed to be containers the importation of which is prohibited.

(b) Containers imported in transit or for transshipment shall be duly exported or transhipped within Two MONTHS from the date of completion of discharge of importing ship.

11. (a) Containers imported in transit or for transshipment shall not be entered for use in Nigeria unless written authorisation from both the consignor and the consignee that the containers may be so treated are produced to the proper officers.

(b) Containers imported into Nigeria for home use shall not be entered in transit or for transshipment.

12. Notes on Containers.—Notes on Containers are at Annex "C" to this Notice.

(ii) letters of types of designs of the manufacture }

2. To ensure that the provisions of the Container Convention are adhered to, the following procedure shall apply :—

(a) The owner or operator of a container must nominate a representative in this country

(b) The owner/operator or representative will undertake in writing to :—

(i) Supply to Customs detailed information concerning movements of a container including dates and places of entry and exit

(ii) Pay import duty and other charges if conditions for temporary importation has not been fulfilled.

## 3. USE OF CONTAINERS IN INTERNAL TRAFFIC

The Container could only be used once in internal traffic before being re-exported. The date of re-exportation must in any event not be more than 12 months from the date of the original importation.

## DIPLOMA AND CERTIFICATE COURSES

APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION  
1979-80 SESSION

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for admission in October 1979 to any of the following courses leading to the award of the Certificates or Diploma of the University.

## 1. FACULTY OF SOCIAL SCIENCES

(a) *Diploma Course in Mass Communication.*—One-year (Day) course, designed primarily for practitioners in the mass media. It includes course-work in self expression skills, social studies, and specialized production techniques. Areas of emphasis are: Print Journalism, Broadcasting; and Public Relations and Advertising.

(b) *Diploma in Social Development and Administration.*—Two-year (Day) course designed for candidates aged 19 and above. However, preference will be given to applicants under 45 years whose ability, personal qualities and experience fit them for social work.

## 2. FACULTY OF ARTS

\**(a) Proficiency Certificate Course in French Language.*—Two-year (Day) or (Evening) Course leading to the award of a Proficiency Certificate in the French Language.

\**(b) Proficiency Certificate courses in Nigerian Languages (for non-speakers of each language).*—Two-year (Evening) Courses in Edo (Bini), Hausa, Igbo and Yoruba leading to the award of a Proficiency Certificate in each Language.

\*The Proficiency Certificate is not to be regarded as a teaching qualification.

(c) *Diploma Course in Yoruba Studies.*—One-year (Day) Diploma Course. This is an Introductory Course in Yoruba Language, Literature and Culture Designed for authors, broadcasters and other users of the language.

## 3. FACULTY OF EDUCATION

(a) *Nigerian Certificate in Education Course.*—Three-year course leading to the Nigeria Certificate in Education.

(b) *Teachers' Diploma in Yoruba Studies.*—One-year course leading to the Teachers' Diploma in Yoruba Studies.

(c) *Associateship Diploma in Education.*—This course is a full-time one-session programme oriented towards Teaching and Curriculum Development in *Primary School Mathematics and Sciences or English and Social Studies*. Applicants are required to select one of the two combinations indicated in the relevant section of the application form.

The programmes are designed to create a cadre of *Educational Leaders in Primary Mathematics and Science Education or English Tutors in Teachers' Colleges, Tutors of in-Service Training Courses*

for *Primary Teachers, Headmasters in Primary Schools, and Education Supervisors and Curriculum Leaders in Ministries.*

(d) *Associateship Diploma in Pre-School Education.*—This course is a full-time one-year programme oriented towards Teaching and Curriculum Development in Pre-Primary Schools.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. (a) *Diploma Course in Mass Communication.*—A minimum of five subjects in the General Certificate of Education at Ordinary Level including English Language. (Credits gained in West African School Certificate will be accepted as equivalents of passes at Ordinary Level in GCE). Merit in English in Teachers' Grade II Certificate is also acceptable.

In addition, candidates should normally have had three full years practical experience in Mass Communication media.

Candidates may also be required to give satisfactory performance in a prescribed admission test.

(b) *Diploma in Social Development and Administration.*—(i) GCE Ordinary Level in at least five subjects including English Language, or its equivalent. (Credits at West African School Certificate).

(ii) Grade II Teachers' Certificate with five subjects at merit level including English Language.

The following categories of applicants are eligible and will be given preference in the order stated below:—

(i) Candidates with Certificate in Social Work/Community Development in any approved institution.

(ii) Untrained serving social workers who have requisite academic qualification.

(iii) Candidates with experience and qualifications in other professions such as nursing, youth leadership, etc. who wish to transfer to Social Work.

(iv) Candidates with basic academic qualifications.

2. (a) *Proficiency Certificate Course in French Language/Nigerian Language (for non-speakers of each language).*—The course is designed for University staff and other approved persons from outside the University, e.g. diplomats, professionals, company executives, housewives, etc. with keen interest in the specific language.

(b) *Diploma Course in Yoruba Studies.*—(i) Grade II Teachers' Certificate or the West African School Certificate with at least 'merit/credit' respectively in Yoruba.

(ii) General Certificate of Education 'O' Level with passes in at least five subjects, including Yoruba.

3. (a) *Nigeria Certificate in Education Course.*—(i) General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) or its equivalent in five appropriate subjects including English Language and the two subjects which

candidates intend to offer for the NCE course, except physical Education which is not a WASC subject.

(ii) Grade II Teachers' Certificate with credits or merit in five subjects including English Language, and the two subjects which the candidate intends to offer for the NCE course.

Candidates offering Science subjects may also qualify if they hold GCE (Ordinary Level) or its equivalent in Five appropriate subjects and a pass in English Language of the West African School Certificate.

Candidates offering Physics must have achieved the GCE (Ordinary Level) standard in Mathematics.

General Science may be accepted in lieu of one Science subject.

(b) *Teachers' Diploma in Yoruba Studies.*—Teachers' Grade II Certificate with at least merit in Yoruba and a minimum of 5 years teaching experience. Credit at the West African School Certificate or pass at the General Certificate of Education ('O' Level) in Yoruba will be acceptable in lieu of merit or above in Yoruba at the Teachers' Grade II Certificate.

(c) *Associateship Diploma in Education.*—Teachers' Grade I or II Certificate plus at least five years' teaching experience after obtaining the Teachers' Grade II Certificate.

(d) *Associateship Diploma in Pre-School Education.*—Teachers' Grade II Certificate plus at least five years' teaching experience including one year at the Nursery School after obtaining the Teachers' Grade II Certificate.

#### EQUIVALENTS (FOR EDUCATION COURSES ONLY)

Merits gained in the Grade II Teachers' Certificate will be accepted as the equivalent of passes at the Ordinary Level in GCE.

*Entrance Examination.*—The entrance examination for admission to these courses (3a, b, c, and d above) will be held in Lagos, Ile-Ife, Ibadan, Ilorin, Benin-City, Kaduna, Enugu, Kano, Jos, Port Harcourt, Calabar and Maiduguri on Saturday, April 28, 1979. Applications for the courses should therefore indicate clearly in the space provided on the application forms, the examination centre of their choice.

*Method of Application.*—Requests for application forms should be addressed to the ADMISSIONS OFFICER, marked "APPLICATION FORM".
