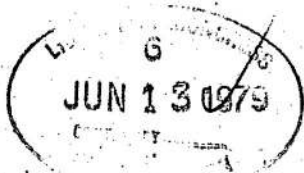

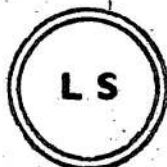

Tenders are invited for the financing and construction of the above mentioned works from Civil Engineering Contractors currently registered in category 'G' with the Ondo State Works Registration Board or category 'D' with the Federal Works Registration Board.

2. The contractor shall state his extra percentage over and above the normal basic tender price (which excludes the financing element) for financing and also state the rate of interest, periods of moratorium and repayment and any other condition(s) they may wish to stipulate.

3. The works consist of the supply and laying of asbestos cement and steel pipes including installation of valves and accessories to supply water to the following towns and villages :—

The total length of the asbestos cement pressure pipes will be approximately 515 km. (320 miles) ranging from 100 mm. (4 inches) to 500 mm. (20 inches) in diameter, whilst the total length of G.I. and steel pipes will be approximately 118 km. (73 miles) ranging from 20 mm. ( $\frac{3}{4}$  inch) to 700 mm. (28 inches) in diameter.

4. Tenderers are requested to note that they may in addition, as an alternative, quote for the supply of prestressed concrete pressure pipes and fittings in lieu of asbestos cement pressure pipes and fittings for diameters varying from 300 mm. (12 inches) to 500 mm. (20 inches) of a total length of 91 km. (56 miles) approximately and also for steel pipes and fittings of diameters varying from 400 mm. (16 inches) to 700 mm. (28 inches) of a total length of 39 km. (24 miles) approximately. The prestressed concrete pressure pipes and fittings may be manufactured at the site of works to conform to the B.S.S. 4625 of 1970 or equivalent.

5. The supply of pipes and accessories will be prime cost items. Whilst the contractors are expected to invite quotations from sub-contractors for supply of pipes and accessories, nevertheless, the Ondo State Water Corporation is not bound to accept the winning tenderer's nominated sub-contractors and the Ondo State Water Corporation may, on its own, also invite quotations for these pipes and accessories and appoint suitable sub-contractors with whom the winning tenderer shall be required to place order in accordance with Clause 59 of General Conditions of Contract.



6. All quotations for pipes and accessories shall be on the basis of fixed prices, i.e. allowing no variation on any basis whatsoever.

7. Any tenderer who is unable to obtain quotations for the supply of pipes and accessories within the stipulated closing date should complete item 4.2 of page Q14 and item 5.2 of page Q15 of volume II and return the tender documents with volumes I and II (completed) and volume III (unfilled).

8.
