Whereas by section 4 (1) of the Sharia Court of Appeal Law of the former Northern Nigeria as amended in respect of the former North-Central State by section 3 of the Sharia Court of Appeal Law (Amendment) Edict 1970 of that State it is provided that the Sharia Court of Appeal shall consist of a Grand Kadi and not less than two other Judges learned in the Sharia:

AND WHEREAS by section 54 (3) of the Constitution of the former Northern Nigeria modified by the Constitution (Basic Provisions) Decree 1975 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1976, it is provided that if the office of any Judge of the Shara Court of Appeal other than the Grand Kadi is vacant or if the person holding the office is acting as Grand Kadi or is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person, with such qualifications as may be prescribed by law to act in the office of a Judge of the Sharia Court of Appeal:

Now, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint UMARU IBRAHIM to act as a Judge of the Sharia Court of Appeal of Kaduna State with effect from the 1st day of September, 1978.
