The census will be carried out by the CSO, a senior statistician, who will be appointed as Census Officer to be the *de facto* head of the census Office to be created within the CSO. The Government Statistician will be the *de jure* head. An executive Officer will be in charge of the administrative aspects of the census preparations. At a later stage district census offices will be set up.
