In pursuance of the policy of the Senate of the University of Lagos to encourage students of exceptional ability and merit to undertake studies leading to Higher Degrees in various disciplines, the Senate awards annually a number of Post-graduate Scholarships and Bursaries based on the advice of the scholarship Committee after considering applications from graduates.
