IN THE MATTER OF SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE DISPUTES (ESSENTIAL SERVICES) DECREE, 1976

AND

IN THE MATTER OF A TRADE DISPUTE BETWEEN NIGERIAN PORTS AUTHORITY AND NIGERIAN PORTS AUTHORITY WORKERS' UNION

WHEREAS a trade dispute has arisen and new exists between Nigerian Ports Authority and Nigerian Ports Authority Workers' Union.

AND WHEREAS the endeavours to promote a settlement by Conciliation have proved unsuccessful;

Now therefore, I, Silvanus Olatunde Williams, Federal Commissioner for Labour, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Section 5 of the Trade Disputes (Essential Services) Decree, 1976 hereby refer the matters in dispute to the Industrial Arbitration Panel with the following terms of reference:—

To inquire into the trade dispute notified by the Nigerian Ports Authority Workers' Union against the Nigerian Ports Authority over the following points:—

(i) Dismissal and Termination and Suspension of some Security Staff.

(ii) Absorption of Nigerian Ports Authority Security Personnel into the Nigerian Police Force.

- (iii) That all those who were designated Quay Supervisors or Senior Clerical Supervisors on Grade Level 05 as from 1st October, 1976 to 30th November, and including 6th December, 1977 before the agreement that took their colleagues with the same designations and being on the same Grade Level 05 to Grade Level 06 should be advanced to Grade Level 06 so as to remove the frustration of remaining on Grade Level 05 while their colleagues on Grade Level 05 with them up to and including 6th December, 1977 were advanced to Grade Level 06.
- (iv) That all Quay Staff and Clerical Supervisors on Grade Level 04 who took the prescribed test and passed with 60 per cent pass mark should be advanced to Grade Level 05 with effect from two years after their employment with the Nigerian Ports Authority in accordance with the agreements of 1st and 6th December, 1977 and 2nd August, 1978

and to make such awards, having regard to the circumstances of the dispute, and such other matter pertaining thereto or arising therefrom as the Industrial Arbitration Panel may deem necessary.
