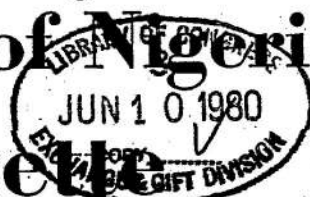

NOW THEREFORE, I, SILVANUS OLATUNDE WILLIAMS, FEDERAL COMMISSIONER FOR LABOUR, YOUTH AND SPORTS, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 5 of the Trade Disputes (Essential Services) Decree No. 23 of 1976 hereby refer the matters in dispute to the Industrial Arbitration Panel with the following terms of reference:—

To inquire into the trade dispute notified by the Nigerian Civil Service Union against the Federal Ministry of Establishments over the following points:—

- “(i) Lift the wage freeze ;
- “(ii) Restore the vehicle advance and basic allowance and to release the Ola Vicent Committee report on Motor Vehicle Advance and Basic Allowance ;
- “(iii) Extend the payment of rent subsidy to workers on Grade Levels 01-07; and
- “(iv) Release the Schemes of Service ;”

and to make such award having regard to the circumstances of the dispute, and such other matters pertaining thereto or arising therefrom as the Industrial Arbitration Panel may deem necessary.
