SPECIAL EDUCATION, IBADAN
VACANCY FOR THE PRINCIPAL

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates, Nigerians and Expatriates, for appointment as Principal of the Federal Advanced Teachers' College (Special Education), Ibadan. The institution is temporarily sited in Oyo, and is managed by the Federal Ministry of Education.

2. The Federal Advanced Teachers' College (Special Education) is an affiliate of the University of Ibadan Institute of Education. It prepares students for the Nigeria Certificate in Education in various fields of Special Education. It provides teachers with the appropriate cognitive, affective and the psychomotor skills appropriate for helping and teaching the various types of handicapped children in primary, secondary and teacher education institutions. In addition, the college will train personnel for supporting services.

3. *Qualifications and experience.*—(i) Candidates should possess at least a good Honours Degree preferably in any field of study in Special Education from a recognised University. A professional diploma or certificate in any field of special education where the degree is not in special education will be an advantage.

(ii) The candidates should have at least 12 years' post-graduate teaching experience, proven institutional administrative ability, experience both in teacher education and co-ordination of handicapped education programmes.

4. *Salary.*—Grade Level 14 or 15—(₦9,168-₦10,128 and ₦10,296-₦11,328) respectively. Point of entry will depend on qualifications, ability and experience.

5. *Conditions.*—Appointment is on either permanent or on contract basis or on secondment for an agreed period. Only indigenous officers will be appointed on permanent basis or secondment. Appointment on contract will be for two tours of between 18 and 24 months depending on the officers' age. A contract officer will be paid 10 per cent contract addition.

Additional benefits for such appointee include institutional holiday, passages for wife and four children, under 12 years of age or 2 children under 18 years of age.
