NATIONAL ASSEMBLY AND STATE ASSEMBLIES (CONVENING OF FIRST SITTING)
PROCLAMATION



By His Excellency General OLUSEGUN OBASANJO. Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces, Federal Republic of Nigeria

GENERAL OLUSEGUN OBASANJO, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces

Whereas it is necessary to appoint the date of the first sitting of the National Assembly and the Houses of Assembly of the States and to specify the time and venue of such sitting:

Now, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 (b) of the Constitution (Basic Provisions) Decree 1975 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf do hereby appoint 2nd October, 1979 as the date of the first sitting and hereby specify that the sitting shall be at 10 a.m. and—

- (a) in the case of the National Assembly, the venue shall be at the Parliament Buildings, Tafawa Balewa Square in Lagos; and
 - (b) in the case of any House of Assembly of a State, the venue shall be at the capital of the State concerned.
