CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA 1979

PROCLAMATION FOR CONVENING THE FIRST SESSION OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY



By His Excellency Shehu USMAN ALIYU SHAGARI, President and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federation.

WHEREAS it is provided in subsection (3) of section 60 of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1979 that the person elected as President shall have power to issue a Proclamation for the holding of the first session of the National Assembly immediately after his being sworn in :

Now, THEREFORE, I, SHEHU USMAN ALIYU SHAGARI, PRESIDENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA AND COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE FEDERATION, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by subsection (3) of section 60 aforesaid, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, hereby proclaim that the first session of the National Assembly shall hold at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, 9th October, 1979, in the Parliament Buildings, Lagos.

GIVEN under my hand and the Public seal of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, at Lagos, this 3rd day of October, one thousand, nine hundred and seventy-nine.
