(a) Nominations may be made by individuals or their sponsors for preliminary evaluation.

(b) Each nomination shall be in the form of a two foolscap-page submission ; one page only of curriculum vitae and the other stipulating the area of activity/accomplishment and the reason(s) why the nominee is considered eligible for the award.

(c) The closing date for the receipt of nominations is 31st May, 1980. Any nomination not received by that date will not be considered for the 1980 exercise.
