The said receipt will be founded upon at the trial of this case.

14. Sometime in 1978, 1st defendant also submitted, at the Accounts Department of the plaintiff at Ikeja, another receipt No. 124145 dated 12th June, 1978 for the sum of ₦36,000.00 purporting it to be a receipt issued by the plaintiff acknowledging payment of the said sum of ₦36,000.00 purportedly received from 1st defendant as a deposit for the importation of two sets of industrial shoe-making machines. The said receipt will be founded upon at the trial of this case.
15. The first defendant did not deposit the said sum of ₦36,000.00 or part thereof with the plaintiff for the said importation or for any other purpose.
16. The plaintiff did not issue the said receipt and it did not emanate from any of the plaintiff's departments.
17. The receipt No. 124145 referred to in paragraph 14 of this statement of claim also purported to be in respect of some industrial shoe-making machines to be used for exhibitions.
18. On the strength of this receipt No. 124145 another voucher No. 78/646 of 14th November, 1978 was purportedly raised by the plaintiff at its Accounts Department, Ikeja in favour of the 1st defendant for the refund of the purported deposit of ₦36,000.00 referred to in paragraph 14 of this statement of claim. The said voucher will be founded upon at the trial of this suit.
19. The said voucher was purportedly signed by one Mr Mbata a servant of the plaintiff working at the Accounts Department of the plaintiff at Ikeja, but Mr Mbata did not sign or prepare the said voucher.
20. The said voucher never passed through the Refunds and Drawback Section or other charges seat of the plaintiff.
21. By the receipts No. 124144 and No. 124145 referred to in paragraphs 7 and 14 of this statement of claim, the first defendant purported to have paid to the plaintiff a total sum of ₦108,000.00 as deposits on industrial shoe-making machines to be imported by the 1st defendant for exhibition purposes.
22. The first defendant never paid the said sum of ₦108,000.00 or part thereof to the plaintiff as deposit for any purpose.
23. On the strength of the receipts No. 124144 and No. 124145 referred to in paragraphs 7 and 14 of this statement of claim and the vouchers referred to in paragraphs 11 and 17 of this statement of claim, the plaintiff issued to the first defendant a Cheque No. 30/LA 198153 of 31st January, 1979 in the sum of ₦107,998.00 after the sum of ₦2.00 had been deducted as administrative Charges on the deposit of ₦108,000.00 purportedly made by first defendant. The said Cheque will be founded upon at the trial of this case.
24. The said Cheque was paid to the first defendant through the Central Bank of Nigeria into the accounts of the first defendant with the United Bank for Africa Limited, Idumagbo Avenue Branch, Lagos.

25. The second defendant is a signatory for the first defendant's account with the United Bank for Africa Limited, Idumagbo Avenue Branch, Lagos.

26. On the 30th of January, 1979, on the instruction of 2nd defendant, one Mrs Funke Balogun, a Clerical Assistant of the plaintiff, working under the second defendant at the Account's Department of the plaintiff at Ikeja, took the said vouchers to the Accounts Headquarters of the plaintiff at Balogun Street, Lagos for processing.

27. The said Mrs Funke Balogun collected the cheque referred to in paragraph 21 of this statement of claim from the said Accounts Headquarters of the plaintiff at Balogun Street, Lagos where the cheque was prepared and handed it over to the second defendant.

28. The cheque referred to in paragraph 21 of this statement of claim was erroneously paid by mistake and without any consideration whatsoever by the plaintiff to the first defendant as a result of the misrepresentation of the false receipts and vouchers earlier on referred to in this statement of claim.

29. The said sum of ₦107,998.00 is still in the account of the first defendant with the United Bank for Africa Limited, Idumagbo Avenue Branch, Lagos.

30. An Order freezing the said account of the first defendant with the United Bank for Africa Limited, Idumagbo Avenue Branch, Lagos was given by this Honourable Court on the 11th of May, 1979, pending the determination of this suit.

31. Wherefore the plaintiff claims from the defendants jointly and severally the sum of ₦107,998.00 paid wrongly and without any consideration whatsoever by the plaintiff to the first defendant.
