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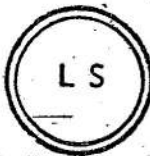

WHEREAS by section 228 (2) of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1979 it is provided that the Federal High Court shall consist of a Chief Judge of the Federal High Court and such number of Judges of the Federal High Court as may be prescribed by law :

AND WHEREAS by section 229 (1) of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1979 it is provided that the appointment of a person to the office of a Judge of the Federal High Court shall be made by the President on the recommendation of the Federal Judicial Service Commission :

NOW, THEREFORE I, SHEHU USMAN ALIYU SHAGARI, President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federation, acting on the advice of the Federal Judicial Service Commission, do hereby appoint Mr TAJUDEEN ADEWALE ODUNOWO as a Judge of the Federal High Court with effect from the 10th day of February, 1981.
