To inquire into the trade dispute existing between the National Union of Road Transport Workers and the Management of Plateau State Transport Corporation over the following point :—

(i) "Refusal to allow union to organise workers in the corporation into the fold of the union". and to make such awards having regard to the circumstances of the dispute and such other matters pertaining thereto or arising therefrom as the Industrial Arbitration Panel may deem necessary.
