In the absence of tax exemption, tax paid will be reimbursed in accordance with an ILO document which may be supplied on request. Although quoted in US dollars, salaries and allowances are payable partly in the currency of the country of assignment and partly in a freely chosen currency.

The pensionable renumeration of this assignment ranges from US \$44,982 to US \$72,166 and the (net) base salary ranges from US \$25,672 to US \$39,485. The salary on appointment will be fixed on the basis of the qualifications, experience and family status of the person selected. The base salary will be supplemented by an annual post adjustment ranging from US \$16,024.70 to US \$23, 430 which is subject to future changes depending on the fluctuation of cost-of-living index and the exchange rate.

General project information.—The organisational and structural arrangements in the Ministry of Manpower and Transmigration were established to manage a network of 14 to 17 vocational and agricultural training centres. In view of the accelerating establishment of additional new training centres between 1976 and 1984, increasing the number of new vocational centres to well over 300, there is a need to establish a national training authority assisted by a permanent secretariat responsible for occupational standards, curriculum development, manpower planning and skill needs analysis, staff training, training aids material development, evalua-tion and research, in-plant training and apprenticeship training. To ensure linkage between the national training authority and the provinces, regional committees will be established, similar in structure (tripartite) and having similar responsibilities.

Description of duties.—The consultant in management of vocational training centres will work under the guidance of the co-ordinator in planning and organising the national training systems and cooperating with other members of the international team and national counterpart staff.

As a member of the international team the expert's main duty will be to assist with and advise on development and establishing the management of vocational training systems in accordance with the over-all objective of the project.

Specifically the consultant will:

- (1) advise on and assist with the development of an organisational structure for the secretariat of the national training authority;
- (2) specify the posts by titles in the organisation with their interrelation, and prepare detailed job descriptions for all key posts;
- (3) arrange training programmes for selected training centre directors to enable them to plan, organise, and implement the administrative and training activities of their centres more efficiently;
- (4) prepare an operational management training manual for training centre directors;
- (5) arrange a transitional plan for transferring experienced and trained national staff to carry out similar functions with the secretariat;
- (6) organise training programmes for training officers from industry to enable them to plant their own in-plant training;

(7) prepare and submit to the co-ordinator such reports as requested on the above-mentioned activities;

ay perform any other duties in connection with the assignment which are within his particular competence as a consultant in the management of vocational training centres.

Qualifications required :

- (1) a good general, technical and management education and training at university level or equi-valent professional level in engineering;
- (2) considerable experience in managing vocational/industrial training at the national level or in a large enterprise;
- (3) adequate training and experience in the field of managing training systems;
- (4) good knowledge of the vocational training planning, organising and running of training centres;
- (5) the ability to plan, co-ordinate, and implement management training programmes in developing countries:
- (6) aptitude to adapt to new working conditions and establish good working relations with international and national staff.

Languages .- Thorough knowledge of written and oral English. Basic knowledge of Bahasa Indonesia would be extremely useful.
