## DEED OF ASSIGNMENT

This deed of Assignment is made the 11th day of April, 1983 Between the Nigerian National Petroleum Corporation (hereinafter called the NNPC) of the first part and Elf Nigeria Limited (hereinafter called Elf) of the second part.

#### WHEREAS-

- 1. By a Joint Venture Agreement dated the 31st day of May, 1972 made between the Federal Military Government of Nigeria and Safrap (Nigeria) Limited (which Agreement as amended from time to time is hereinafter called the 'said Agreement') the parties thereto agreed to co-operate in oil exploration in the areas covered by the Oil Mining Leases 56, 57, 58 and 59 held by Safrap.
- Safrap (Nigeria) Limited has changed its name to Elf Nigeria Limited.

- 3. The Federal Government of Nigeria (hereinafter called the Government) has created the NNPC, to which it has assigned all its rights and obligations under the said Joint Venture Agreement.
  - 4. By mutual consent of NNPC and Elf the said Agreement was amended to increase the NNPC's participating interest in the Joint Venture to 60 per cent and to correspondingly reduce Elf's participating interest therein to 40 per cent.
- 5. NNPC is the holder of or is entitled to hold the Oil Prospecting Licence (OPL) No. 447 which covers parts of the former OPLs 38, 39, 40, 41 and 48 previously held by Safrap and subsequently revoked by the Government.
- 6. Both parties wish to extend the scope and area of the said agreement to include the exploration and production of petroleum on the said OPL and therefore NNPC has agreed to assign and Elf has agreed to take an undivided participating interest of 40 per cent of the said OPL.
- 7. It is the intention of the parties hereto to use their best efforts to obtain the transformation of the said OPL into OML, which OML shall also be held under and in accordance with the terms of the said Agreement in like manner as the said OPL.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS :-

ARTICLE 1.—Assignment:

Subject to the consent of the Government and in consideration of the amounts payable pursuant to articles 4 and 6 hereof, NNPC hereby assigns to Elf Nigeria Limited an undivided forty per cent (40%) interest in the OPL 447.

ARTICLE 2.

Notice of the Assignment contained herein of a 40 per cent interest in OPL 447 from NNPC to Elf shall be published in the Federal Government Gazette as soon as possible.

ARTICLE 3.—Extension of Joint Venture Agreement:

The scope of the Joint Venture Agreement is therefore hereby extended to cover the area of the said OPL and accordingly as of the date on which this agreement and the assignment herein contained come into force the provisions of the Joint Venture Agreement shall comprehensively apply to the OML 56, 57, 58, 59 and to the said OPL and to any OML or other petroleum exploitation right granted in respect of the area of the said OPL, and all further expenditure in respect of the said OPL for the exploration and production of oil shall be made by NNPC and Elf in the ratio 60-40 respectively.

ARTICLE 4.—Acquisition Right Premium (BONUS):

Within thirty (30) days from the execution of this agreement Elf Nigeria Limited shall pay the Government an acquisition right premium of five (5) million US dollars.

ARTICLE 5.—Training and Participation of NNPC

Personnel;
(a) For the duration of this agreement NNPC shall have the option to assign to NNPC/Elf Joint Venture operations a maximum of 8 'trainees' at a time (i.e. staff of between 1 and 3 years experience) and to second a maximum of 8 'professionals' at a time (i.e. staff of over 5 years experience), each group to be composed of 2 Geophysicists, 2 Geologists, 2 Engineers, and 2 Accounting officers.

(b) NNPC 'professionals' seconded to NNPC! Elf Joint Venture operations for specific working

assignments will enjoy Elf's salaries and conditions of service for the duration of their secondment, and shall be paid by Elf from Joint Venture funds.

- (c) NNPC 'trainees' on assignment to NNPC/ Elf Joint Venture operations for training will retain NNPC's salaries and conditions of service. For greater administrative convenience, such staff shall also be paid by Elf from Joint Venture funds.
- (d) The duration of each specific assignment or secondment of NNPC personnel to NNPC/Elf Joint Venture operations shall be agreed upon between the parties, provided however, that the 'trainees' would be assigned for between 6 and 12 months, and the 'professionals' would be seconded for between 9 and 18 months.

ARTICLE 6.—Consideration for the Assignment:

In consideration for the assignment contained herein, it is agreed that Elf Nigeria Limited will bear alone the following expenditures:

- (a) an amount of three (3) million naira or the equivalent in foreign currency shall be paid for the carrying out of NNPC's own National Reserves Evaluation Project according to the progress of the works as reported by the consultant company in charge of the said evaluation.
- (b) an amount of two (2) million naira or the equivalent in foreign currency that shall be invested by Elfalone in two Joint Venture projects promoted by NNPC and related to the establishment of a Seismic Processing Centre and Seismic Party; such amount shall be paid according to the progress of construction of the seismic party and processing centre. Such projects shall become part of the Joint Venture operations but shall be treated separately particularly with respect to their accounts due to their specific nature and purpose. When Elf Nigeria Limited shall have spent alone for its own account and for NNPC's account a sum of two (2) million naira or the equivalent in foreign currency NNPC shall have the option to buy back at cost the Elf Nigeria Limited's 40% share of any or all projects under this paragraph, and until such time as this buy back is made Elf Nigeria Limited shall be allowed to use the facilities of any such project at a preferential rate to be agreed upon, taking into account its participation in the project.

It is the understanding of the parties that subject to the Petroleum Profits Tax Act and any subsequent amendment made thereto, the amounts under more paragraphs (a) and (b) above will be treated as exploration expenditure for tax purposes in Elf's account. In the event that the applicable tax authority decides not to treat in Elf's account the amounts of three (3) million naira and two (2) million naira stated above in this Article 6 as exploration expenditure, NNPC and Elf shall meet and review the said amounts for the purpose of compensating Elf in respect of such decision.

ARTICLE 7.— Continuity of NNPC's Programmes:

Elf hereby agrees to review all of NNPC's exploration programmes in OPL 447 and to continue such programmes to the extent that Elf is satisfied with NNPC's current exploration drilling proposals. Consequently, NNPC shall furnish Elf with all documentation and information in respect of work previously carried out by NNPC on OPL 447.

ARTICLE 8.—Use of NNPC's Party X, Party Y and Processing Centre:

Elf hereby agrees to use any of NNPC's seismics parties, including that established under subclause (b) of Article 6 above provided that their services are offered on a competitive basis in respect of price quality and availability, and to process some of its data at the Seismic Processing Centre established under subclause (b) of Article 6 above.

ARTICLE 9.—Coming into Force and Duration!

- (a) This agreement shall come into force on January, 1983.
- (b) This Agreement shall remain in force from the date it comes into force until the termination of the OPL 447 or any OML or other petroleum exploration or exploitation right derived there from or for a period of 20 years from 1st January, 1983 whichever shall first occur, subject however to any renewals or extensions mutually agreed upon between the parties.
