# PUBLIC NOTICE

PRODUCTIVITY, PRICES AND INCOMES BOARD

### **INCOMES POLICY GUIDELINES, 1984**

The Federal Military Government has approved the guidelines on wages, salaries, fringe benefits, professional incomes, dividends and prices for the year 1984. Accordingly, pursuant to Section 4(5) of Decree No. 30 of 1977, the Productivity, Prices and Incomes Board hereby issues the following notice for the guidance of the general public.

### A. WAGES AND SALARIES

Preamble—The present economic situation in the country which is characterised by reduced output, substantial decline in profit levels and actual losses in some cases; the retrenchment of workers and the closure on some establishments, rising costs of living, and the current measures in force to mitigate the impacts, should be a matter of serious concern to labour and management alike in public and private sectors. Whilst the Government has introduced measures to reduce suffering, workers must strive hard to raise productivity and should resist the temptation to press for higher salaries, wages or fringe benefits. Without enhanced productivity, increases in the remuneration of workers will simply lead to a higher rate of inflation and a fall in the living standards of all categories of workers. The provisions of the guidelines should be seen in this context.

#### Private Sector

- (i) In view of the present economic difficulties and in support of the efforts of the Government to solve them, no general percentage increase in salaries and wages will be permitted in 1984. Normal annual increments will, however, be allowed but adjustments in incremental rates remain forbidden.
- (ii) All establishments employing fifty or more persons are required to submit to the Ministry of Employment, Labour and Productivity, produc-tivity schemes drawn up with their employees, and full information on wages, salaries and fringe benefits paid to all categories of their employees, together with the number of employees in each occupational group.
- (iii) No revision of fringe benefits or introduction of new ones will be valid except with the approval of the Ministry of Employment, Labour and Productivity. Companies applying for the revision of fringe benefits or the introduction of new ones are required to enclose a copy of their productivity schemes. Evidence of improvement in productivity and increased profits should also be shown.
- (iv) All festival or end-of-year bonus payments shall be regarded as ex-gratia payments by the management and shall not be subject to negotiation. No employee shall receive in any one calendar year an amount higher than one month's basic pay by way of such ex-gratia payments. Proposals for the payment of festival or end of year bonus to workers shall be submitted to the Ministry of Labour and Productivity for Employment, approval.

### Public Sector

- (v) For the reasons stated in section A (i) above, no general percentage increase in salary and wages shall be permitted in 1984. Normal annual increments will, however, be permitted but adjustment in incremental rates remain forbidden :
- (vi) Changes in fringe benefits in the Civil Service shall be based on the studies carried out by the Pay Research Unit, while for the rest of the Public Service, applications for changes shall be submitted to the Minister of Employment, Labour and Productivity;

(vii) Ex-gratia payments to workers may be approved by the Government after clearance with the Minister of Finance. The maximum permissible limit shall be as provided in A (iv) above.

# General Application to both Sectors

(viii) Changes in salaries, wages and fringe benefits shall not be backdated except in the case of promotion or advancement of staff.

### B. PROFESSIONAL INCOMES

- (i) Increases in the fees paid to non-executive Directors of companies will not be permitted in 1984.
- (ii) Government approved rates for professional services such as those provided by Architects, Estate Managers, Locum Medical Doctors, Engineers, Quantity Surveyors, etc. shall not be exceeded, in both the public and private sectors.
- (iii) The scale rates for fees charged by accounting and auditing firms for 1981 shall be applicable in 1984. However, where substantial expansion in the scope of work has taken place as a result of opening of new branches or the expansion of existing facilities, an increase not exceeding 5% of the total sum payable in 1983 may be effected. Increases beyond this level will require the approval of the Productivity, Prices and Incomes Board.
- (iv) The payment of fees, charges, retainers, etc. higher than those specified in (i)—(iii) above will not be accepted by the Internal and Inland Revenue Departments as expenses for tax purposes.

### C. DIVIDENDS

- (i) Dividends up to 60% of the current year's after-tax-profit may be declared and distributed. In the case of pioneer companies, up to 60% of the current year's profit before-tax may be declared and distributed.
- (ii) A witholding tax of 12.5% is payable on all dividends. This provision does not apply to pioneer companies.
- (iii) The issue of scripts based on a revaluation of assets is forbidden;
- (iv) For effective monitoring, Companies are required to submit a copy of their detailed annual reports and management accounts to the Secretary, Productivity, Prices and Incomes Board and to the Head, Incomes Analysis Unit, Federal Ministry of National Planning.
- (v) For the avoidance of doubt, the guidelines which obtain on the date of a company's annual general meeting shall apply in determining its distributable dividends provided that the timing of the annual general meeting is in accordance with the provision of Section 124 (i) of the Companies Act 1968.

### D. PRICES

- (i) An increase in price of not more than 5% may be effected during the year after prior consultation with, and consent of, the Board. Applications for such increases should be submitted to the Permanent Secretary/Chairman, Productivity, Prices and Incomes Board, at least 4 weeks before the date of the proposed increase. Applications for price increases of more than 5% shall be submitted at least 6 weeks in advance.
- (ii) Companies applying for price increase should enclose copies of their Annual Reports and Management Accounts for the preceding three years. Detailed cost information and data in support of the application should also be enclosed.
- (iii) Importers of heavy industrial machinery for resale should not apply a mark-up of more than 25% of the C.I.F.
- (iv) Importers/dealers in motor spare-parts should not apply a factor of more than 2.0 on C.I.F. Other officially approved local costs may be added to arrive at the selling price.
- (v) Increase in the rates charged for advertisements in the media as well as fees and commissions charged by advertising agencies should be made in the manner stipulated in paragraphs D (i) and D (ii) above.
- (vi) Increase in rentals paid for the hire and maintenance of machines and equipment should be made in the manner stipulated in paragraphs D (i) and D (ii) above.
- (viii) Where there is a net reduction in allowable costs per unit of output, prices should be reduced by an amount equal to the percentage reduction resulting therefrom. The Board may, therefore, call on any firm to reduce prices if there is evidence of reduction in allowable costs.
- (viii) It is forbidden for companies to apply for price increases on the basis of anticipated increases in costs.
- (ix) All advertisements for the sale of goods and services in any news media must carry actual prices of the particular goods or services advertised.
- (x) The prices of all traded goods and service must be conspicously exhibited to guide consumers.

### E. CERTIFICATION

Auditors reports on companies and other institutions must contain statements as to whether or not the provisions of the Incomes Policy Guidelines, as specified above, have been adhered to in every respect.

### F. PENALTY

Failure to comply with the provisions of these guildelines shall be punishable under section, 5 (2) of Decree No. 30 of 1977.
