PRODUCTIVITY, PRICES AND INCOMES BOARD

INCOMES POLICY GUIDELINES, 1985

The Federal Military Government has approved the guidelines on wages, salaries, fringe benefits, professional incomes, dividends and prices for the year 1985. Accordingly, pursuant to Section 4 (5) of Decree No. 30 of 1977, the Productivity, Prices and Incomes Board hereby issues the following notice for the guidance of the general public.

A. WAGES AND SALARIES

Preamble

'Although Government has taken a number of steps to restore economic activities to their former levels, the economy is still relatively depressed since the full impact of the new measures are yet to be realised. For this reason, the current policies on wages and prices which call for restraint will be maintained. Whilst efforts to reduce suffering will continue, all should strive hard to increase productivity since without this, it will be difficult or even impossible to achieve higher living standards and the orderly development of the economy.

Private Sector

- (i) In view of the continuing economic difficulties and in support of the efforts of the Government to solve them, no general percentage increase in salaries and wages will be permitted in 1935. Normal annual increaments will, however, be allowed but adjustments in incremental rates remain forbidden.
- (ii) All establishments employing fifty or more persons are required to submit to the Ministry of Employment, Labour and Productivity, productivity schemes drawn up with their employees, and full information on wages, calaries and fringe benefits paid to all categories of their employees, together with the number of employees in each occupational group.
- (iii) No revision of fringe benefits or introduction of new ones will be valid except with the approval of the Ministry of Employment, Labour and Productivity. Companies applying for the revision of fringe benefits or the introduction of new ones are required to enclose a copy of their productivity schemes. Evidence of improvement in productivity should also be shown.
- (iv) All festival or end-of-year bonus payments shall be regarded as ex-gratia payments by the management and shall not be subject to negotiation. No employee shall receive in any one calendar year an amount higher than one month's basic pay by way of such ex-gratia payments. Proposals for the payment of festival or end of year bonus to workers shall be submitted to the Ministry of Employment, Labour and Productivity for approval.

Public Sector

- (v) For the reasons stated in Section A (i) above no general percentage increase in salaries and wages shall be permitted in 1985. Normal annual increments will, however, be permitted but adjustments in incremental rates remain forbidden.
- (vi) Ex-gratia payments .to workers may be approved by the Government after clearance with the Minister of Employment, Labour and Productivity. The maximum permissible limit shall be as provided in A (iv) above.

General Application to both Sectors

(vii) Changes in salaries, wages and fringe benefits shall not be back-dated except in the case of promotion or advancement of staff.

B. PROFESSIONAL INCOMES

- (i) Increases in the fees paid to non-executive Directors of companies will not be permitted in 1985.
- (ii) Government approved rates for professional services such as those provided by Architects, Estate Managers, Locum Medical Doctors, Engineers, Quantity Surveyors, etc., shall not be exceeded in both the public and private sectors.
- (iii) In view of the continuing restraint on wages and salaries, no increases will be permitted in 1985 in the fees charged by accounting and auditing firms.
- (iv) The payment of fees, charges, retainers, etc. higher than those specified in (i)-(iii) above will not be accepted by the Internal and Inland Revenue Departments as expenses for tax purposes.

C. DIVIDENDS

- (i) Dividends up to 60% of the current year's after-tax-profit may be declared and distributed. In the case of pioneer companies, up to 60% of the current year's profit before tax may be declared and distributed.
- (ii) A withholding tax of 15% is payable on all dividends. This provision does not apply to pioneer companies.
- (iii) The issue of scripts based on revaluation of assets is forbidden.
- (iv) For effective monitoring, companies are required to submit a copy of their detailed annual reports and management accounts to the Secretary, Productivity, Prices and Incomes Board and to the Head, Incomes Analysis Unit, Federal Ministry of National Planning.
- (v) For the avoidance of doubt, the guidelines which obtain on the date of a company's annual general meeting shall apply in determining its distributable dividends provided that the timing of the annual general meeting is in accordance with the provisions of section 124 (i) of the Companies Act, 1968.

) PRICES

- (i) An increase in price of not more than 5% may be effected during the year after prior consultation with, and consent of the Board. Applications for such increases should be submitted to the Permanent Secretary/Chairman, Productivity, Prices and Incomes Board, at least 4 weeks before the date of the proposed increase. Application for price increases of more than 5% shall be submitted at least 6 weeks in advance.
- (ii) Companies applying for price increases should complete Form PPIB/DS/1 and enclose copies of their Annual Reports and Management Accounts for the preceding three years. Detailed cost information and other relevant data in support of the application should also be enclosed.
- (iii) Importers of heavy industrial machinery should not apply a mark up of more than 22.5% on the C.I.F. Other local costs such as import duty, handling and clearing charges, etc., may be added to arrive at the selling price.

- (iv) Importers of automotive and machinery spare parts should not apply a mark up of more than 20% on the C.I.F. Other local costs such as import duty, clearing and handling charges, etc., may be added to arrive at the selling price.
- (v) Importers of pharmaceutical products should not apply a mark up of more than 20% on the C.I.F. Other local costs such as import duty, clearing and handling charges, etc., may be added to arrive at the selling price.
- (vi) Applications for an increase in the rates charged for advertisements in the media as well as fees and commissions charged by advertising agencies should be made in the manner stipulated in paragraphs D (i) and D (ii) above.
- (vii) Applications for an increase in rentals paid for the hire of machines and equipment should be made in the manner stipulated in paragraphs D (i) and D (ii) above.
- (viii) Service charges for the maintenance of technical equipment, e.g. generators and computers, etc. should not be raised during 1985. Spare parts, accessories and consumables should however be invoiced at cost.
- (ix) Where there is a net reduction in allowable cost per unit of output, prices should be reduced by an amount equal to the percentage reduction resulting therefrom. The Board may, therefore, call on any firm to reduce prices if there is evidence of reduction in allowable costs.
- (x) It is forbidden for companies to apply for price increases on the basis of anitcipated increases in costs.
- (xi) Advertisements for the sale of goods and services in the news media should carry actual prices of the particular goods or services advertised.
- (xii) The prices of all traded goods and services should be conspicuously exhibited to guide consumers.
- (xiii) In order to discourage hoarding and profiteering, major manufacturers and importers are required to monitor the activities of their distributors. Companies will be required to render periodic returns to the Productivity, Prices and Incomes Board on their distribution arrangements.

E. CERTIFICATION

Auditors reports on companies and other institutions must contain statements as to whether or not the provisions of the Incomes Policy Guidelines, as specified above, have been adhered to in every respect.

F. PENALTY

Failure to comply with the provisions of these guidelines shall be punishable under section 5 (2) of Decree No. 30 of 1977.
