THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FORMECU, IBADAN AND THE AFFORESTATION
PROJECT CO-ORDINATING UNIT, KANO

In accordance with the conditions for a World Bank Loan to execute the Forestry II Project in Bauchi, Borno, Kaduna, Kano, Sokoto, Plateau, Benue, Ogun and Ondo States of Nigeria with Forestry Management Evaluation and Co-ordinating Unit (FORMECU) with Headquarters in Ibadan to co-ordinate the activities of the aforementioned States, which shall have a regional office called APCU located in Kano.

The Federal Government of Nigeria hereby establishes the Unit to be known as FORMECU with regional office called APCU in Kano.

Title.—This notice may be cited as the Establishment of Forestry Management Evaluation and Co-ordinating Unit (FORMECU) with Headquarters in Ibadan and Afforestation Project Co-ordinating Unit (APCU) with Headquarters in Kano Notice 1986.

Forestry Management, Evaluation and Co-ordinating Unit (FORMECU)

(1) FORMECU will carry out the following functions and responsibilities in respect of the Project, under the overall supervision of the Head of FORMECU assisted by adequate professional and support staff.

(2) Functions and responsibilities :

- (a) Overall co-ordination and monitoring of the execution of the Project including the monitoring of the accounts of all Project executing agencies ;
- (b) Regularly advising the Director of FDF of progress in Project implementation ;
- (c) Recruitment of long-term resident experts and consultants ;
- (d) Financial management of and book-keeping for FORMECU Special Account and FORMECU Revolving Fund and for FMAWRRD funds allocated to the Project States ;
- (e) Assistant to Project States on policy and financial matters concerning the execution of the Project ;
- (f) Employment of the following specialists : (i) a Financial Adviser ; (ii) a Senior Monitoring and Evaluation Officer ; (iii) a Data Processing Analyst ; (iv) a Forest Management and Utilization Officer ; (v) two Forest Utilisation and Marketing Officers ; (vi) a Training Officer and (vii) Head FORMECU.

Staffing :

(3) FDF shall assign to FORMECU officers not below the rank of Senior Forest Officers to work with the specialists referred to in (2) above. One of the assigned officers not below the rank of Principal Forest Officer shall be appointed as Deputy Head of FORMECU. FORMECU shall be provided with the following additional staff : one Administrative Assistant, six Monitoring and Evaluation Officers, two Accountants, two Senior Accounts Supervisors, Four Accounts Supervisors, a Transport Officer, a Stores Officer, Secretaries/Typists, Clerks, Drivers and other support staff as needed.

Composition :

(4) FORMECU shall have Forest Project Advisory Board consisting of the following :

- (a) Minister, FMAWRRD—Chairman ;
- (b) Permanent Secretary, FMAWRRD—Vice-Chairman ;
- (c) Director of Forestry, FDF ;
- (d) Director, Federal Department of Rural Development ; and
- (e) Head of FORMECU—Executive Secretary.

The Board shall meet at least twice a year to review Project activities in the forestry sector and to advise both State and Federal Government agencies on new strategies in the said sector.

Management Committee :

(5) FORMECU shall have a Management Committee consisting of the following :

- (a) Head of FORMECU—Chairman ;
- (b) Deputy Head of FORMECU ;
- (c) Financial Adviser ;
- (d) Senior Monitoring and Evaluation Officer ;
- (e) Training Officer ; and
- (f) Principal, Oluwa Forestry Manpower Development Centre.

The Management Committee shall be responsible for the day to day Operation of FORMECU's programme and shall regulate its own proceedings.

Afforestation Project Co-ordinating Unit (APCU)

(1) Subject to the overall guidance of FORMECU, APCU shall ensure the overall technical supervision of the execution of Part A of the Project. To this end, APCU shall liaise between FDF and the Project States, monitor and evaluate progress made under said Part of the Project, co-ordinate research, training, and extension activities and procurement. APCU will also be responsible for preparing the National Afforestation Plan.

(2) Composition :

APCU will comprise four divisions :

(a) The Finance and Procurement Division responsible for :

(i) keeping the accounts in respect of Part A of the Project ; and (ii) preparing disbursement and applications and bidding documents.

(b) The Technical Division responsible for (i) Planning and designing all technical specifications to be followed in the carrying out of all field operations ; and (ii) determining research priorities and negotiating the necessary arrangements for carrying out said research.

(c) The Training and Extension Division responsible for : (i) determining the training needs for staff at all levels in the Project States ; (ii) developing and carrying out training programmes designed to meet needs ; (iii) administering the Kano Forestry Vocational Development Centre ; and (iv) developing such extension programmes in consultation with the staff of the relevant Agricultural Development Projects.

(d) The monitoring and Evaluation Division responsible for : (i) formulating guidelines to be followed in monitoring the progress of the Project ; (ii) collecting relevant information and drafting reports for management stressing problem areas and suggesting the necessary corrective measures to be taken.

(3) Staffing :

APCU will be headed by a Project Co-ordinator who will be assisted by the following specialists ; (i) a Financial Controller ; (ii) a Monitoring and Evaluation Officer ; (iii) a Silviculturist/Agro-forestry Officer ; and (iv) an Extension and Training Co-ordinator. APCU shall be provided with the following staff : one Accountant ; four Monitoring and Evaluation Officers ; one Administrative Assistant ; one Stores Officers ; two Accounts supervisors ; Secretaries/Typists ; and Clerks and other support staff as needed.

Management Committee

(4) APCU shall have a Management Committee consisting of the following :

(a) Head of APCU—Chairman ;

(b) Deputy Head of APCU ;

(c) Financial Controller ;

(d) Silviculturist/Agro-Forestry Officer ;

(e) Training and Extension Officer ;

(f) Monitoring and Evaluation Officer ; and

(g) Principal, Kano Forestry Vocational Development Centre.

The Management Committee shall be responsible for the day to day operation of APCU'S programme and shall regulate its own proceedings.
