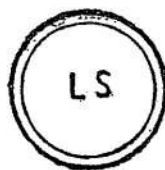

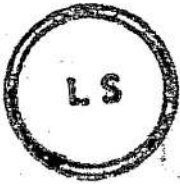

Terms of appointment.—The monthly net salary for this assignment ranges from US \$3,023.50 to US \$3,553.25. It is normally free of income tax.
