ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria—

- 1. The National Automotive Council Act (in this Act referred to as "the Principal Act") is amended as set out in this Act.
- Amendment of No. 84 of 1993.
- 2. Section 9 of the Principal Act is amended in subsection (1) by deleting Amendment paragraph (a) thereof and consequently renumbering the remaining paragraphs (b) to (f) as paragraphs (a) to (e) respectively.
