TRANSFER OF CONVICTED OFFENDERS (ENACTMENT AND ENFORCEMENT) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2013

ACT No. 1

An Act to amend the Transfer of Convicted Offenders (Enactment and Enforcement) Act Cap. T16, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004;

and for Related Matters

[21st Day of January, 2013]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria -

The Transfer of Convicted Offenders (Enactment and Enforcement) Act Cap.
 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 (in this Act referred to as "the Principal Act") is amended as set out in this Act.

Amendment of Cap T16 LFN, 2004.

2. Section 5 (1) of the Principal Act is amended by substituting for paragraph (d), a new paragraph (d).

Amendment of Section 5.

"(d) if the convicted offender is sentenced to not less than 12 months imprisonment and where both countries agree."

3. Section 8 of the Principal Act is deleted.

Deletion of Section 8.

4. This Act may be cited as Transfer of Convicted Offenders (Enactment and Enforcement) (Amendment) Act, 2013.
