FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA, 1999 (AS AMENDED)

WHEREAS by section 230(2) of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (As Amended), it is provided that the Supreme Court shall consist of a Chief Justice of Nigeria and such number of Justices of the Supreme Court, not exceeeding Twenty-One, as may be prescribed by an Act of the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria;

WHEREAS by section 231(2) of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (As Amended), it is provided that the appointment of a person to the office of a Justice of the Supreme Court of Nigeria shall be made by the President on the recommendation of the National Judicial Council, subject to the confirmation by the Senate;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary that the instrument in evidence of the aforesaid appointment of a Justice of the Supreme Court of Nigeria be executed by the authority now competent to make such appointment;

Now THEREFORE, I, DR. GOODLUCK EBELE JONATHAN, President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, acting on the recommendation of the National Judicial Council and confirmation by the Senate, do hereby appoint HONOURABLE JUSTICE KUDIRAT M. O. KEKERE-EKUN, JCA as a Justice of the Supreme Court of Nigeria with effect from the 2nd day of July, 2013.
