

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX, FREETOWN.

2ND QUARTER, 1972.

The following table shows how much was spent for various items by average low income African families in Freetown during 1961 and what the equivalent cost would be at the prices prevailing in the first quarter, 1972, and the second quarter, 1972. The relative changes in

prices are shown by the index numbers.

Consumer prices rose by 41.7 per cent between the second quarter, 1972, and the average for 1961. The 'all items' index was 141.7 (1961 = 100). The index for the quarter under review reflected an increase of 1.1 per cent when compared with that for the corresponding quarter in 1971. There was a fall of 2.6 per cent in the index for the quarter under review when compared with that for the first quarter, 1972. The fall in the index was mainly due to decreases in average price of a number of items in the 'food and drink' and 'miscellaneous' groups.

Food and Drink—There was a fall of 4.8 per cent in the index for this group as a result of a substantial fall in the average prices of salt, palm oil and cassava leaves, a relatively moderate fall in the average prices of bananas and okra and a smaller fall mainly in the average prices of mangoes, groundnut oil and potato leaves. These decreases were partially offset by a substantial rise in the average prices of onions and fresh tomatoes a relatively moderate rise in the average prices of Irish potatoes, small peppers, big peppers, and coffee and a smaller rise mainly in the average prices of cassava and oranges.

Housing-This group recorded a rise of 0.1 per cent as a result of a rise in the average price of putty.

Clothing-There was no change in the index for this group.

Miscellaneous-The index for this group fell by 1.6 per cent mainly as a result of a fall in the average prices of kola nuts and soda soap. CONSUMER PRICE INDEX, FREETOWN.


