**STATE ENROLLED NURSES**

3. The course will last two and a half (2½) years and will begin on Monday 5th March, 1973 at the National School of Nursing, Wallace-Johnson Street, Freetown. Practical experience will be gained in certain Freetown Hospitals.

4. During the period of training all pupil nurses will receive (a) free board and lodging (or an allowance in lieu thereof), and (b) a personal allowance of Le168 per annum. All female nurses accepted for this course will be required to be in residence in the Nurses Home and will receive a monthly allowance of Le14. Male pupil nurses should make their own arrangements regarding accommodation and will receive an allowance of Le160 per annum in lieu of free board and lodging as well as Le22 per annum as transport allowance.

5. Candidates who successfully complete the course will be able to apply to the Public Service Commission for appointment as State Enrolled Nurses in the Ministry of Health. The starting salary will be Le459 per annum in Scale N1 i.e. Le358, Le378, Le398, Le419; Le439; Le459, Le479, Le500, Le527B; Le554, Le568, Le594, Le620. Opportunities for promotion will exist for qualified State Enrolled Nurses. Suitably qualified State Enrolled Nurses may be given an opportunity after a period of service for further training at Professional level, provided they have in the meantime obtained the requisite academic qualifications for admission to that training programme.

### ORGANISATION FOR PLANNING

#### COMPOSITION AND TERMS OF REFERENCE OF PLANNING BODIES

In accordance with Government's policy of directing economic development of the country through development plans, a Central Planning Unit has been established, with assistance from UNDP, in the Ministry of Development. The Unit is engaged at present in making sectoral and macro-economic studies preparatory to formulation of a comprehensive medium-term plan. It will also be assisting the Ministry of Development in the preparation of the annual Development Budget and the Sectoral Ministries in preparation of development projects and in instituting appropriate procedures for appraisal of progress on them. Planning and Project Formulation Units have already been created in two Ministries and are proposed to be established in all the important sectoral Ministries.

In order to provide overall direction on the goals, objectives priorities and strategies of the national development plans, as well as to formulate policies and programmes for effective plan implementation, Government have decided to set up a National Planning Council. The Council will be headed by His Excellency the President and will have the following as its Members:—

The Vice-President and Prime Minister  
The Minister of Finance  
The Minister of Development  
The Minister of Agriculture and Natural Resources  
The Minister of Trade and Industry  
The Minister of Education  
The Minister of Health  
The Minister of Works  
The Minister of Lands and Mines  
Governor, Bank of Sierra Leone

The Council will have the following terms of reference:—

- (i) to indicate the basic goals and objectives of planning;
- (ii) to decide for each plan, the macro-economic variables, such as the rate of economic growth and the magnitudes of investment, domestic savings and foreign aid, as well as the resource allocations among programmes and projects and the physical accomplishment targets;
- (iii) to provide all other guidelines on economic and social policies and on programmes and projects, which are needed by the planners for plan formulation;
- (iv) to approve the plans before they are presented to the Parliament and the public;

- (v) to decide on monetary, fiscal, foreign trade and other economic policies needed for mobilization of resources for effective implementation of the plans or for direction of the economy in keeping with plan objectives;
- (vi) to review progress of the plans from time to time and decide on changes in them, based on the reviews or changes in the domestic or international situation.

The Council shall be assisted by an Inter-Ministerial Committee of Permanent Secretaries, headed by the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Development. The principal functions of the Committee will be:—

- (i) to examine with a view to advising the National Planning Council, all papers relating to formulation and implementation of the national development plan;
- (ii) to decide on proposals relating to less important policies, programmes and projects, in case of which reference to the National Planning Council is not necessary, but interministerial action is involved;
- (iii) to serve as the principal executive organ for inter-ministerial co-ordination in formulation and implementation of development programmes.

Sub-Committees and Inter-Ministerial or Technical Working Groups will be set up from time to time as considered necessary by Government.

In order to associate non-official interests, such as business industry and labour, as well as distinguished scholars, scientists and social workers with the planning process, an Advisory Planning Body is proposed to be constituted.

Creation of appropriate planning organisations at regional and local levels is also under the consideration of the Government. Notifications on these subjects will be issued separately.

The Ministry of Development shall serve as the Secretariat of the National Planning Council; the Inter-Ministerial Committee of Permanent Secretaries; the Advisory Planning Board and the various Working Groups and Sub-Committees.

## SIERRA LEONE GOVERNMENT FOREIGN AND COMMONWEALTH OVERSEAS AWARDS FOR HIGHER EDUCATION 1973/74 ACADEMIC YEAR

Applications for scholarships awards are invited from persons who wish to start in the 1973/74 session a course of higher education and who are already qualified to do so.

## 2. The following conditions apply to the above awards:

(a) The applicants should have either at least five General Certificate of Education passes at Ordinary level and two or more "A" level passes OR at least two passes at Royal Society of Arts Stage III level OR at least a pass at Final City and Guilds level. In addition he must prove to the Scholarships Awards Advisory Committee that he is clearly qualified for admission to the course he wishes to follow see (f) below, and (if he wishes to do it overseas) that it is not available locally. In the case of dental medical and paramedical university degrees, grades of B or better are required at 'A' level for admission.

(b) All such awards will take the form of a loan, a proportion of which will be waived for every year the debtor serves in a capacity approved by Government after successfully completing his or her course. An award does not however impose an obligation on Government to employ the holder.

(c) The applicant must be a citizen of Sierra Leone, preferably between the ages of 17 and 40, and fluent in English.

(d) If the course of study, or one which in the opinion of the Scholarships Awards Advisory Committee closely approximates to it, is available locally, the applicant will not be allowed to pursue it overseas under this award.

(e) Allowances are generally intended to maintain the applicant alone and dependants' allowances will not be paid. Where the allowances paid by a donor outside Sierra Leone are regarded by Government as inadequate even to maintain the applicant, he will be advised to what extent they will need to be supplemented from private sources, and whether an advance deposit of this sum is required. Confirmed Civil Servants and confirmed teachers may be considered for study leave in order to take up an award.

(f) Applicants must bring to the interview if in Sierra Leone originals of his certificates confirming his qualifications. Applicants should also bring a current copy of the regulations under which he claims letter of admission from an approved institution of higher education.

(g) If the applicant is abroad photostatic copies of his certificates and other relevant documents must be attached to his application.

(h) All awards are made for one year only in the first instance and are subject to renewal or withdrawal in the light of the holders progress and conduct and (except in the case of National Scholarships) Financial circumstances.

3. A means test will be applied to all candidates for all Sierra Leone Government awards except National Scholarships, and will determine the value of those awards.

4. Applications should be made on forms obtainable from the Ministry of Education, New England, Freetown or from the nearest Inspector of Schools in the Provinces. Applicants in the United Kingdom and the Continent of Europe exclusive of Western Germany should obtain application forms from the Sierra Leone High Commission 33, Portland Place, London W.1. Those in Western Germany, from Sierra Leone Embassy, Bonn, Western Germany, and those in the United States of America and Canada from the Sierra Leone Embassy in Washington, 1701-19th street, N.W. Washington 6, D.C. Candidates in Government Service should submit two applications: one direct to this Ministry and the other through their Heads of Department. Heads of Departments are requested to forward these applications to the Establishment Secretary for Transmission to this Ministry.

6. All applications must reach the Ministry of Education, Freetown not later than 18th November, 1972. Qualified applicants in Sierra Leone will be interviewed by the Scholarship Awards Advisory Committee during the five days beginning Tuesday, 21st November, 1972 at 9 a.m. each day. They will be informed by a notice posted on the notice board the previous day on which particular day they will be required. Applicants outside Sierra Leone will be considered in absentia. Persons without the qualifications and proof specified in paragraph 2(a) above need not apply. If they do, they will not be interviewed. Applicants are requested to bring all original certificates and testimonials to the interview. Applications forwarded after 18th November, 1972 will not be accepted.

7. Applicants are informed that Sierra Leone Government awards are not normally made for first degree courses in the United States and Canada because of their high cost. Holders of first degrees obtained overseas who intend to teach are advised in their own interests to consult this Ministry about the advisability of obtaining a second degree before returning home.

AND WHEREAS by Supplementary General Warrant No. 1 under my hand dated 23rd February, 1972 you were authorised to pay out of the said Consolidated Revenue Fund a further sum not exceeding Le2,932,327;

AND WHEREAS an additional appropriation for the service of the Financial Year 1971/72 has been made by the House of Representatives;

AND WHEREAS a further sum has been appropriated by the House of Representatives for the settlement of temporary advances outstanding against the Development Fund up to the 30th day of June, 1971;

**PRIMARY SCHOOLS TEXT BOOKS COMMITTEE**

1. The Twenty-Second International Conference on Public Education held at Geneva in 1959 advised as follows in paragraphs 19 and 20 of Recommendation No. 48.

"19 In countries where the publication of text books for primary schools is the prerogative of private industry, or is not the exclusive responsibility of the education authorities, one of the best means of ensuring that text books used are of good quality is to draw up and keep up to date lists of selected works from which a final choice should be made for each school or group of schools.

20. Committees appointed to draw up lists of selected text books should be completely objective in their choice, taking into account educational and scientific quality, presentation and sale price, as well as possible reactions on the part of parents; such committees should in any case include representations of the primary teaching staff."

2. In accordance with this recommendation the Minister of Education has appointed a Primary Schools Text Books Committee, its terms of reference are as follows:

- To prepare and revise where necessary, a list of selected text books for use in primary schools, using as a basis the Ministry's current list of recommended books and the requirements of the Primary Schools Syllabus in force.
- To encourage the production of suitable text books by local authors; to examine and to recommend suitable texts for trial prior to possible publication.
