THE COMMISSIONS OF INQUIRY ACT

(Cap. 54)

WHEREAS HIS EXCELLENCY THE PRESIDENT is of the opinion that it would be for the public welfare for an unity to be held into the matters hereinafter mentioned:—

Now, THEREFORE, HIS EXCELLENCY THE PRESIDENT in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Sec-2 and 6 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, and acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet hereby this Commission, and appoints Mr. Justice Constant S. Davies, as Chairman, Mr. A. E. Benjamin, Emplo-Federation, Mr. Tejan Kassim, Sierra Leone Labour Congress, the Financial Secretary, the Establishment retary, Mrs. L. D. Deigh, Retired Permanent Secretary, as Members, and Mrs. L. D. Deigh also to be Secretary Commission with the following terms of reference:—

"to examine the General Conditions of Service of the Public Service and the Armed Forces of the Republic of Sierra Leone and to study the existing salary and wage structures of the aforesaid bodies, with a view to recommending new structures, including the determination of a minimum wage, and to make appropriate recommendations having regard to the general economic situation obtaining in Sierra Leone and the need for an efficient and dedicated service."

AND IT IS HEREBY DIRECTED that the Commissioners shall take the Oath before His Excellency The Presi-

AND IT IS HEREBY DIRECTED that the said Inquiry shall be held in public, subject to the discretion of the airman when he considers it necessary in the public interest, to exclude the public or any particular person or sons for the due conduct of the Inquiry or for any other reason.

AND IT IS FURTHER DIRECTED that the report of the Commission shall be tendered to His Excellency The sident, in writing, signed by the Chairman and Members.
