WCF38EA., section, 121 of the Banking Act, 2019 makes general provisions in relation to abundance property.

Fullibers to section 5% of the Banking Act No. o of 2019 which empowers the bank of Sierra Louis to "make togulations, rules and issue directives and guidelines applicable to banks and financial holding companies", the covern a of the Bank of Sierra Louis hereby directs as follows:

Within six months after the expiry of seven years, the bank shall communicate to the customer by letter about the abandoned property and the letter shall be sent to the customer's last known address by registered post; and if the customer fails to respond within the six months the property shall be deemed to have been abandoned and shall without further formship be transferred to the Bank of Sierce Leone to be dealt with in such monner as may be determined by the bank of Sierce Leone.
- 3. The Bank of Sierra Leone shall maintain records of deposits or monies which have been abandoned.
- 4.
