THE HIGH COURT (ARRANGEMENT OF CRIMINAL SESSIONS) ORDER, 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Section 2(1) and 5 of the Criminal Procedure Act No. 32 (High Court Criminal Sessions) Rules S.L. 27 of 1967, I as the Chief Justice of the Republic of Sierra Leone do hereby make the following Order:-

1. That the High Court shall hold Criminal Sessions in Kono, Kailahun, Kailaba, Port Loko, Moyamba in addition to Freetown, Bo Kenema and Makeni on the last Monday in January, the third Monday in May, the third Tuesday in September and the last Monday in November in the year 2021.

**TREATMENT OF FUNDS IN THE ABANDONED PROPERTIES ACCOUNT OF COMMERCIAL BANKS HELD
AT THE BANK OF SIERRA LEONE**

WHEREAS, section 121 of the Banking Act, 2019 makes general provisions in relation to abandoned property.

Pursuant to section 121 of the Banking Act No. 6 of 2019 which empowers the Bank of Sierra Leone to "make regulations, rules and issue directives and guidelines applicable to banks and financial holding companies", the Governor of the Bank of Sierra Leone hereby directs as follows:

1. Any bank holding an abandoned property shall make a report to the Bank of Sierra Leone in the manner determined by the Bank of Sierra Leone stating the nature of the property held and in the case of money, the amount of money.
2. Within six months after the expiry of seven years, the bank shall communicate to the customer by letter about the abandoned property and the letter shall be sent to the customer's last known address by registered post; and if the customer fails to respond within the six months the property shall be deemed to have been abandoned and shall without further formality be transferred to the Bank of Sierra Leone to be dealt with in such manner as may be determined by the Bank of Sierra Leone.
3. The Bank of Sierra Leone shall maintain records of deposits or monies which have been abandoned.
4. Where a claim is made under this section by a person, that person shall submit the details of the claim to the bank where the deposits or monies were deposited upon which the bank shall refer the claim to the Bank of Sierra Leone to enable the Bank of Sierra Leone to ascertain the validity of the claim.
