THE FINANCE AND AUDIT ACT, 1967

(No. 18 of 1967)

THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE POST OFFICE SPECIAL
FUND (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1977

(Under section 12 (4))

(Commencement: 1st April 1978)

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by the above-mentioned Act, the Honourable the Minister for Finance and Economic Planning is pleased to make the following regulations —

Citation and date of commencement.

1. These regulations may be cited as The Administration of the Post Office Special Fund (Amendment) Regulations, 1977, and shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 1978.

Amendment of regulation 4 of The Administration of the Post Office Special Fund Regulations, 1973.

2. Regulation 4 of the above-named Regulations is amended by —

(a) replacing paragraph 4 (1) by the following —

“4 (1) There is hereby established a Board of Management consisting of the following persons —

- (a) Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Works, Power and Communications;
- (b) Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Finance and Economic Planning;
- (c) Permanent Secretary, Department of Establishments and Training;
- (d) Accountant-General
- (e) Director of Posts and Telecommunications;
- (f) Secretary, Swaziland Chamber of Commerce and Industry;
- (g) a person, not being a public officer, appointed by the Minister.”;

(b) replacing paragraph 4 (2) by the following —

“4 (2) The Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Works, Power and Communications shall be chairman of the Board and the Director of Posts and Telecommunications shall nominate an officer in his department as Secretary to the Board”.

Insertion of new paragraph.

3. The following new regulation 8 is hereby inserted immediately after paragraph 7 of The Administration of the Post Office Special Fund Regulations, 1973 —

“8. The fees and allowances payable to the members of the Board mentioned in regulation 4 (1) (f) and (g) shall be determined by the Minister for Finance and Economic Planning from time to time.”
