LEGAL NOTICE NO. 2 OF 1978.

THE ANIMALS DISEASES ACT, 1965

(No. 7 of 1965)

THE STOCK DISEASES (RABIES) (NO. 1) REGULATIONS 1978

(Under Section 3)

(Commencement: 27th January, 1978)

In exercise of powers conferred on him by the above-mentioned Act, the Honourable the Minister for Agriculture is pleased to make the following regulations:-

Citation.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Stock Diseases (Rabies) (No. 1) Regulations 1978.

Declaration of Rabies Guard Areas.

2. The Dipping Tanks and other areas specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be Rabies Guard Areas.

Isolation and Confinement of Dogs in the Guard Areas.

3. Every owner of a dog in any of the Guard Areas shall isolate and confine it as to prevent it from escaping from such guard areas.

Destruction of dogs in Rabies Guard Areas.

4. A Government Veterinary Officer may destroy a dog in any of the Rabies Guard Areas which, in his opinion, has not been confined so as to prevent it from escaping from such guard area.

Offence and Penalty.

5. Every owner of a dog in any of guard areas who contravenes or fails to

comply with regulation 3 shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of E300 or imprisonment for a period of six months.

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 3 OF 1978

THE TELEVISION AUTHORITY ORDER, 1977

(No. 37 of 1977)

TELEVISION VIEWER'S LICENCE REGULATIONS, 1978

(Under Section 11)

.. -16

(Date of commencement: 27th January, 1978)

Acting in consultation with the Television Authority of Swaziland and in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the above-named Order, the Honourable the Deputy Prime Minister is pleased to make the following regulations —

Citation.

11. These regulations may be cited as the Television Viewer's Licence Regulations, 1978.

Je raka kara da

Period of television viewer's licence.

- (1) The period of a valid current television viewer's licence shall be reckoned from the first day of July of any year to the 30th day of June of the following year.
- (2) A person acquiring a television receiver at any time before the 30th June in any year shall be liable to pay a proportionate amount of the prescribed annual television viewer's licence fee for that year reckoned from the date of his acquisition of such receiver.

Form of television viewer's licence.

3. A television viewer's licence shall be substantially in the form as set out in the Schedule hereto.

Change of address.

- 4. (1) A holder of a television viewer's licence shall in writing notify the Swaziland Television Authority of any change in his residential address.
- (2) A holder of a television viewer's licence who fails to comply with paragraph 1 within 14 days of such change shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine of one hundred emalangeni or imprisonment for one month.

Renewal of television viewer's licence.

A holder of a television viewer's licence shall renew it by paying the amount

of the licence fee by not later than the 14th July in any year to the Swaziland Television Broadcasting Corporation Limited or Visionhire (Swaziland) Limited or any other person or authority who may hereafter be prescribed by notice in the Gazette and a newspaper circulating in Swaziland.

Inspection of television viewer's licence.

6. (1) The holder of a television viewer's licence shall exhibit such licence for inspection on demand by a person duly authorised thereto by the Swaziland Television Authority:

Provided that such demand shall be made at a reasonable time.

(2) A person who fails to comply with paragraph (1) shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine of one hundred emalangeni or one month's imprisonment.

TELEVISION VIEWER'S LICENCE

This licence must be retained by the Licensee and produced upon renewal and on demand for inspection by an officer authorised by the Television Authority of Swaziland.

The period of a valid licence is reckoned from the first day of July of any year to the 30th day of June of the following year after which the licence must be renewed. Failure timeously to renew the licence renders the possessor of a television receiver liable to criminal prosecution.

Persons acquiring a television receiver at any date before the 30th June in any year will be liable to pay only a proportionate amount of the total annual licence for the year.

Subject to the Television Authority of Swaziland Order, No. 37 of 1977, a person possessing a television receiving set without the appropriate licence is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding three hundred emalangeni or imprisonment for a period of six months. In addition he remains liable for the full amount of the annual licence fee.

A television viewer's licence is not transferable to any other person by the holder of such licence. The Television Authority of Swaziland, P.O. 1409, Mbabane must be informed in writing of any change of address by the holder of this licence, failing which he may be prosecuted and become liable to pay a fine of one hundred emalangeni or undergo imprisonment for the period of one month.

A duplicate licence may be obtained on application to the Swaziland Television Broadcasting Corporation.
